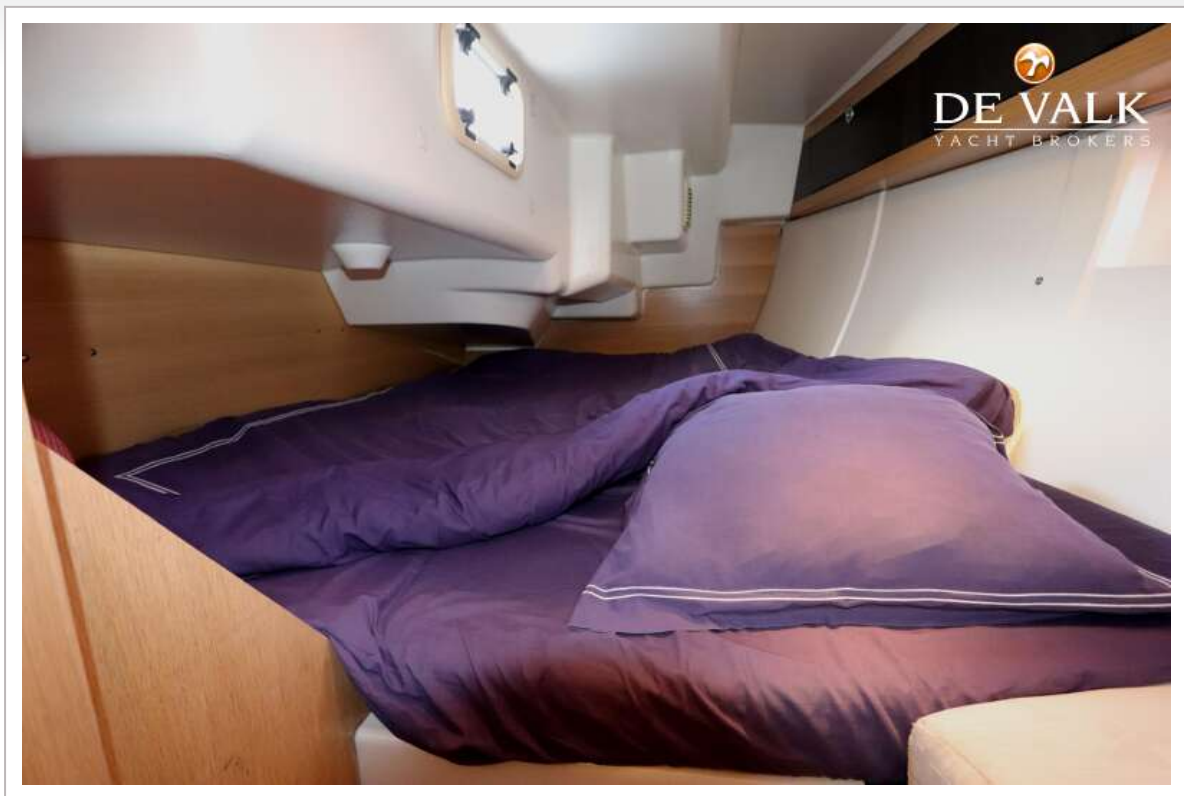




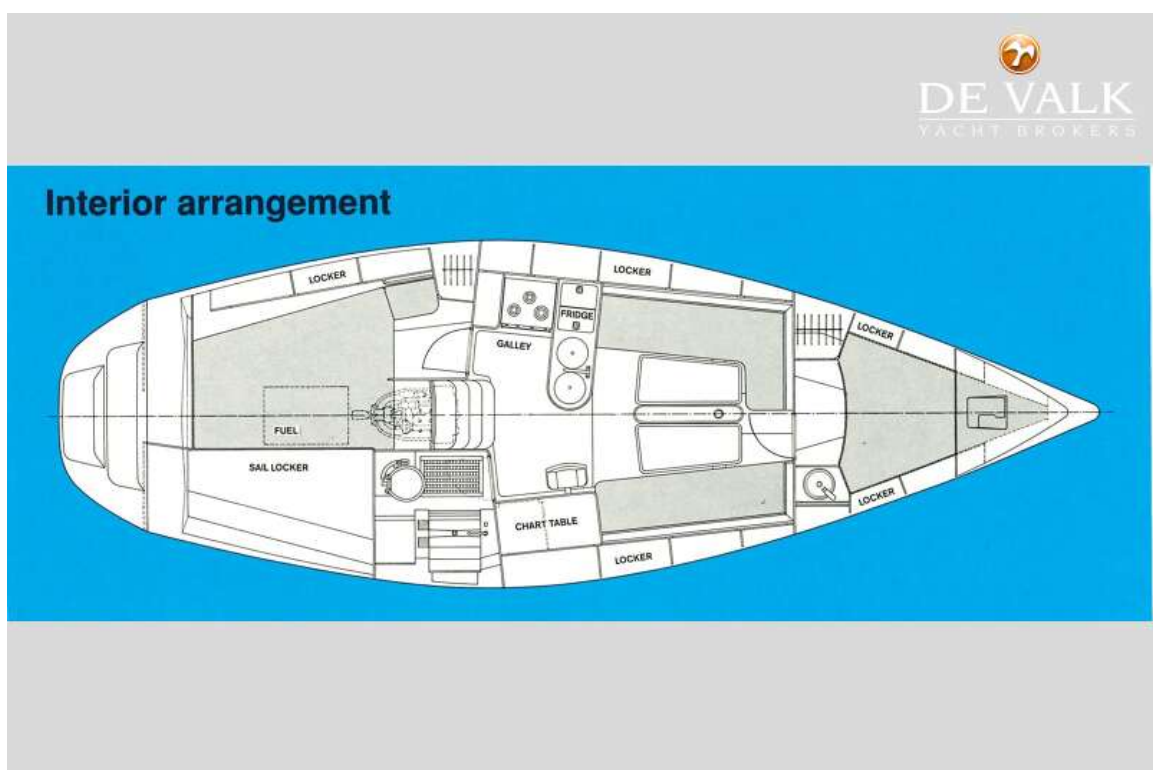














## Deck arrangement
