The owner built it for himself, which can be seen inside. Recently this 'classically lined lady' underwent a technical refit worth > € 25,000: new engine, standing and running rigging, hatches, windows, mast base and support, vhf antenna, windex / windmeter, wiring, toilet, seacocks, many hoses, wiring and batteries. The ship is ready to board. Because there is still some room for aesthetic improvement, we reduced the price.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What is the reason for selling your yacht?

Our time on this wonderful ship is over, due to a new phase of life. We are looking for an enthusiastic successor who will enjoy sailing the 'Katsse Kaa' as much as we do. We can share all information about accommodation and costs in Greece.

How many owners has your yacht had and when?

The 'Katsse Kaa' was built by and for the shipyard's owner (Van der Rest Nautic), which can be seen from the interior that differs slightly from the other Pleiwets 1200 built. The boat was purchased by the current (2nd) owner in 2003.

What can you tell about the history and cruising area of your yacht?

The first owner mainly sailed in Zeeland and along the Dutch and Belgium coast. The present owner also sailed the French coast, Channel Islands, English south and east coast up to Scotland and went to Ireland. In 2012 the Adriatic and Ionian Sea, since then in Greece from Krete to Evia around the Peloponnesus and between the Ionian Isles.

Why did you choose for this yacht when you bought it?

The Pleiwet 1200 is a beautiful designed ship with a very classic line. We loved her flush deck and although her width is only 3.4 m she's been spaciouly furnished.

What is the special meaning of the name of the yacht for you?

Since the shipyard moved to the town "Kats", the owner named all his boats (and also his dogs) 'Katsse Kaa'. The meaning of this name : the quay of Kats.

Has your yacht ever been used for charter? And if so, when?

No, the Pleiwet 1200 has only been used private.

What can you tell about the sailing characteristics of your yacht?

This Pleiwet 1200 is a sporty sailor (cruise racer). Built by one of the GRP pioneers in the Netherlands - Van Der Rest Nautic. She's considered a Dutch GRP classic. Sails comfortably and loves a good trim. She has a flat bottom and needs very little wind to go. Because of this she is slightly under canvased, which is good in her case.

What did you do with your yacht during the winter?

The first owner had her every winter in a winter storage. Since 2003 the boat has been as well in the water as out. The boat has been on shore in Greece from 2019 until May 2023 (because of my husband passing away and Covid). We've used this time to give her a technical refit. Back into the water in September 2022 after the new engine was installed.

What kind of maintenance or renewals have been carried out (with documentation as prove)?

The following has been renewed in the last 5 years: Engine, water lock, exhaust, saildrive membrane, engine room isolation, standing and running rigg, stainless steel goose-neck for wires, mast wires, Lazy Jacks (present but not installed yet), Furlex drum and reefing line, sea railing, deck hatches, windows, 3 batteries, sea-cocks, through hull fittings, drains, VHF antenna, Windex, Windmeter (masthead unit included), toilet, toilet hoses, hot water boiler, compressor for fridge, 70% of the 12 Volt wiring, 2x solar panel on stainless steel bar, gas regulator, gas hoses, windlass and foot buttons, anchoring rope, 60m anchor chain, navigation lights, interior lights partly with LED, mattress in front cabin, taps, one with flexible hose for shower.

The following has been upgraded. Mast and boom repainted, sails cleaned and checked, Easy-Kick overhauled, mast foot and mast support re-installed, winches serviced, entrance and floor varnished, deck and part of superstructure with non-skid repainted, mainsheet traveler has been reinstalled, diesel and fresh water tanks cleaned and equipped with service hatch, antifouling on underwater hull.

What are, according to you, future points of attention with regard to the maintenance of your yacht?

The boat is from 1993 and should be brought to 2023, e.g. tablet holder outside. All the earlier necessary instruments have been removed, this leaves traces. The new motor is slightly bigger and the woodwork in the aft cabin needs to be redone partly. Smaller details s.a. the electrical bilge pump. Some "old" lights should be replaced by LED.
