




































































































FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the reason for selling your yacht? Not enough time to use the yacht sufficiently.

How many owners has your yacht had and when? I am the second owner, I bought the yacht in 2003 from the fist owner.

What can you tell about the history and cruising area of your yacht? Shortly after delivery, the "Blauwe Juffer" was used for the ARC rally, after which the yacht mainly sailed the North Sea and Irish Sea. After 2003 the sailing area was the North Sea, English south coast and northern France. These have mainly been solo trips.

Why did you choose for this yacht when you bought it? Seaworthiness, solid execution/construction and technical complete installation.

What is the special meaning of the name of the yacht for you? No special meaning. This was given by the 1st owner.

Has your yacht ever been used for charter? And if so, when? No.

What can you tell about the sailing characteristics of your yacht?

The yacht needs some wind, it is not a light weather sailor. Therefore the last purchased Genoo was enlarged by 10%. Behavior with more/high wind is impressive. With deep cockpit and the doghouse there is always a wonderfully sheltered place from which everything can be kept an eye on.

What did you do with your yacht during the winter t

If no maintenance was planned, the yacht remained in the water. The soils, steering wheel, cushions and mattresses were removed and all tanks and pumps drained, an electric heater was also installed to prevent any frost. If the yacht remained in the water, it would go ashore in the spring for regular maintenance.

What kind of maintenance or renewals have been carried out (with documentation as prove)?

New ceilings (2021), new windows (2021), new B&G, new batteries, new genoas, refit mast + rigging, large refit of complete yacht.

What are, according to you, future points of attention with regard to the maintenance of your yacht?

Depending on the future sailing area, an electric windlass may be considered. And depending on the intensity of use and any major sailing plans, the mainsail may eventually have to be replaced.

Which four keywords would you use to describe your yacht? Seaworthiness, solid, sleek, tough, timeless.
