

























































































































FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What is the reason for selling your yacht?

I can only free up time to go sailing a few times per year.

Additionally, my wife is not a big fan of sailing, and our free time is mostly spent in other ways.

How many owners has your yacht had, and when?

Two, but the first owner unfortunately passed away before the yacht was delivered. I bought it before it was launched and have, in that regard, remained the only real owner.

What can you tell about the history and cruising area of your yacht?

I am an occasional sailor and have only sailed on the Oosterschelde. This was limited to 5 to 10 times a year.

There were only two overnight stays on the boat, and the kitchen and sanitary facilities remain unused and, like the entire boat, are in mint condition.

Why did you choose this yacht when you bought it?

The combination of its compact dimensions and yet more than sufficient space both on deck and below deck. The modern and high-quality finish was also an important factor. Finally, the yacht received very favorable reviews in the specialized press.

What is the special meaning of the name of the yacht for you?

"Alter Ego" reflects the other person you become while sailing. You briefly forget all daily worries due to the focus that sailing demands.

Has your yacht ever been used for charter? And if so, when?

No, it has only been used personally.

What can you tell about the sailing characteristics of your yacht?

It is a relatively sporty yacht with special sport sails and a folding propeller, making it possible to have a very dynamic sailing experience for its size. Of course, it is also perfectly suited for enjoying a relaxing drink on board.

What did you do with your yacht during the winter?

The yacht remained in the water, with all necessary precautions taken to winterize it and a dehumidifier running constantly. In the spring, just before the sailing season, the boat was taken out of the water for a professional antifouling treatment and engine maintenance by the marina services. All maintenance was always outsourced to professionals.

What are, according to you, future points of attention with regard to the maintenance of your yacht?

The yacht is in new condition and, aside from regular annual maintenance, requires no specific attention.
