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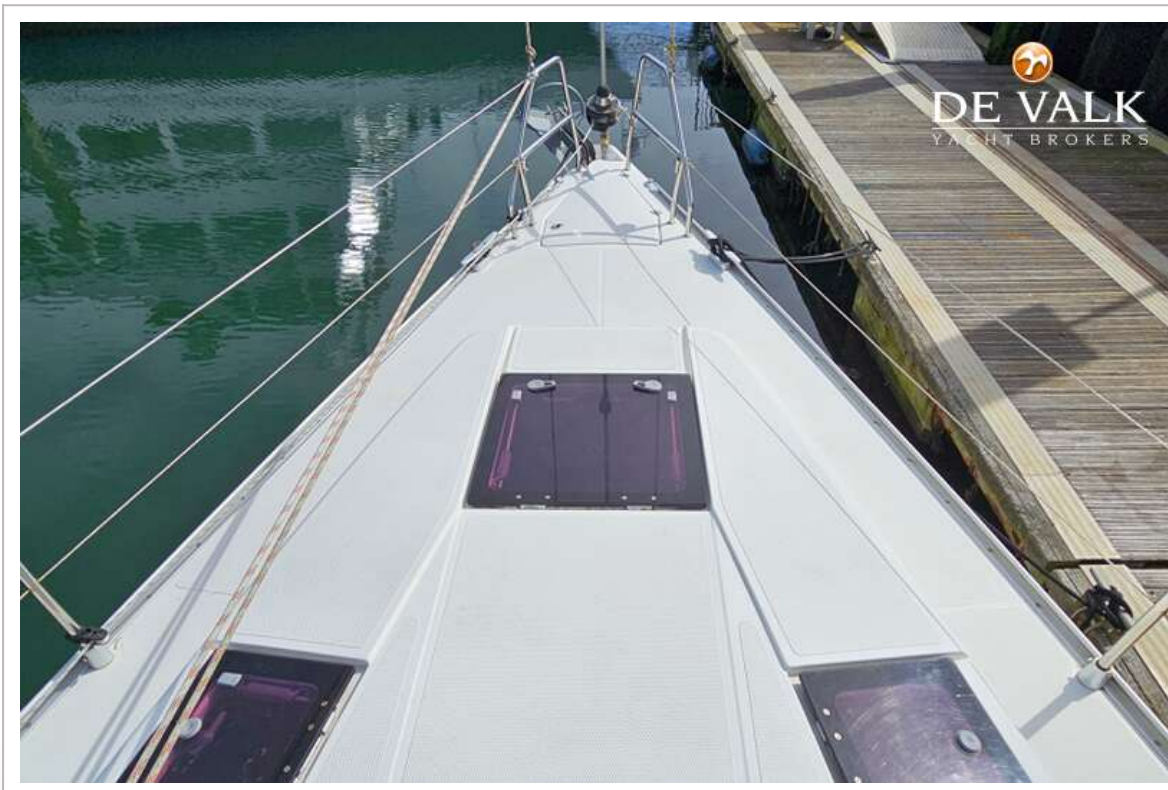
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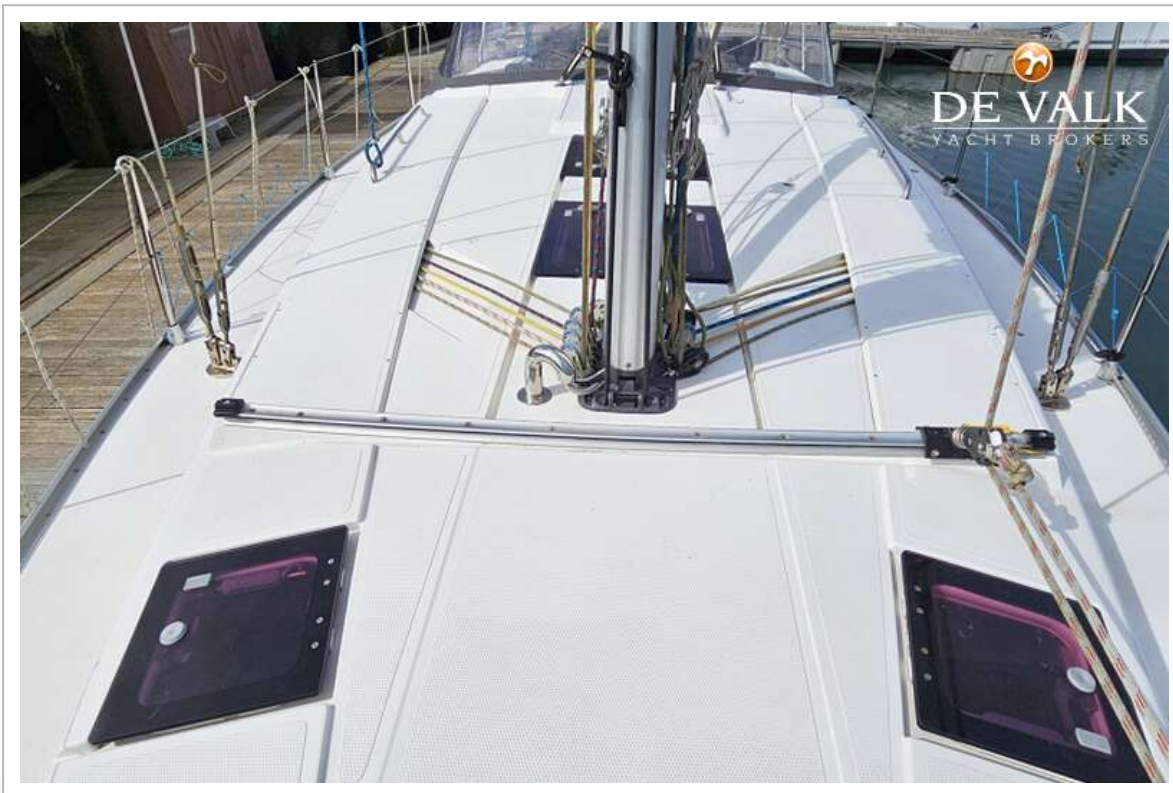
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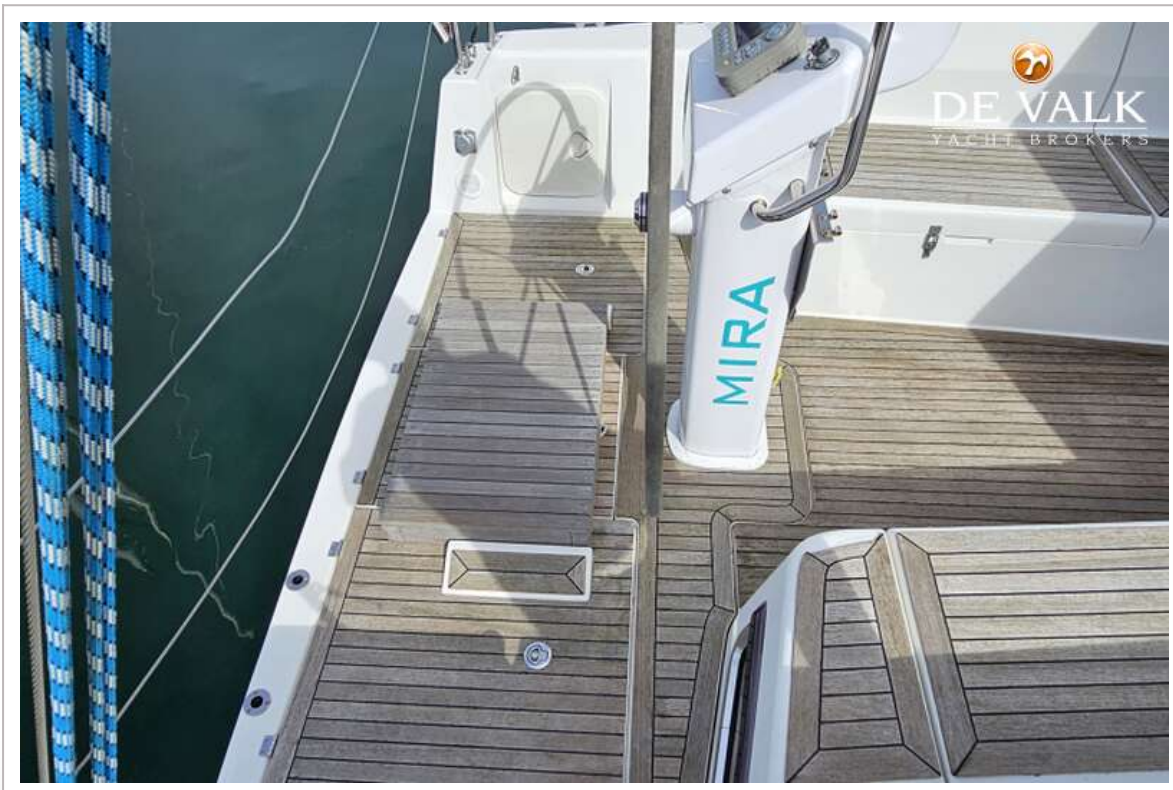
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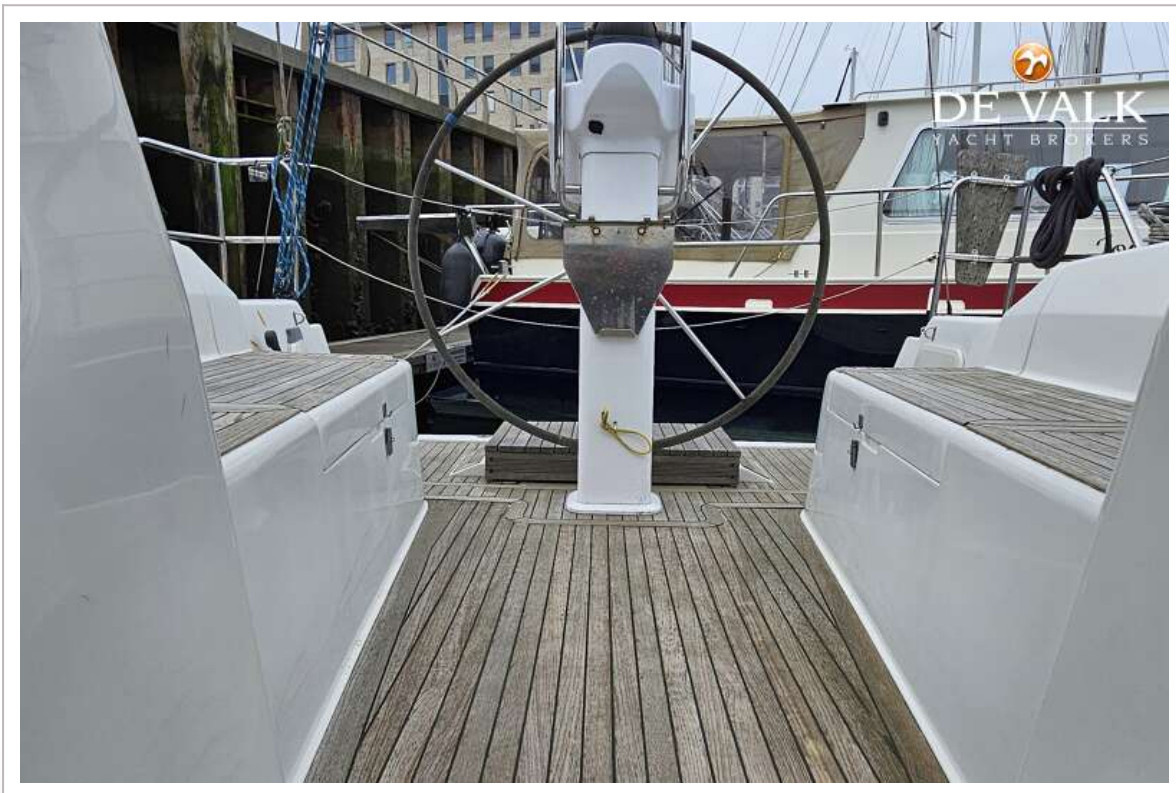
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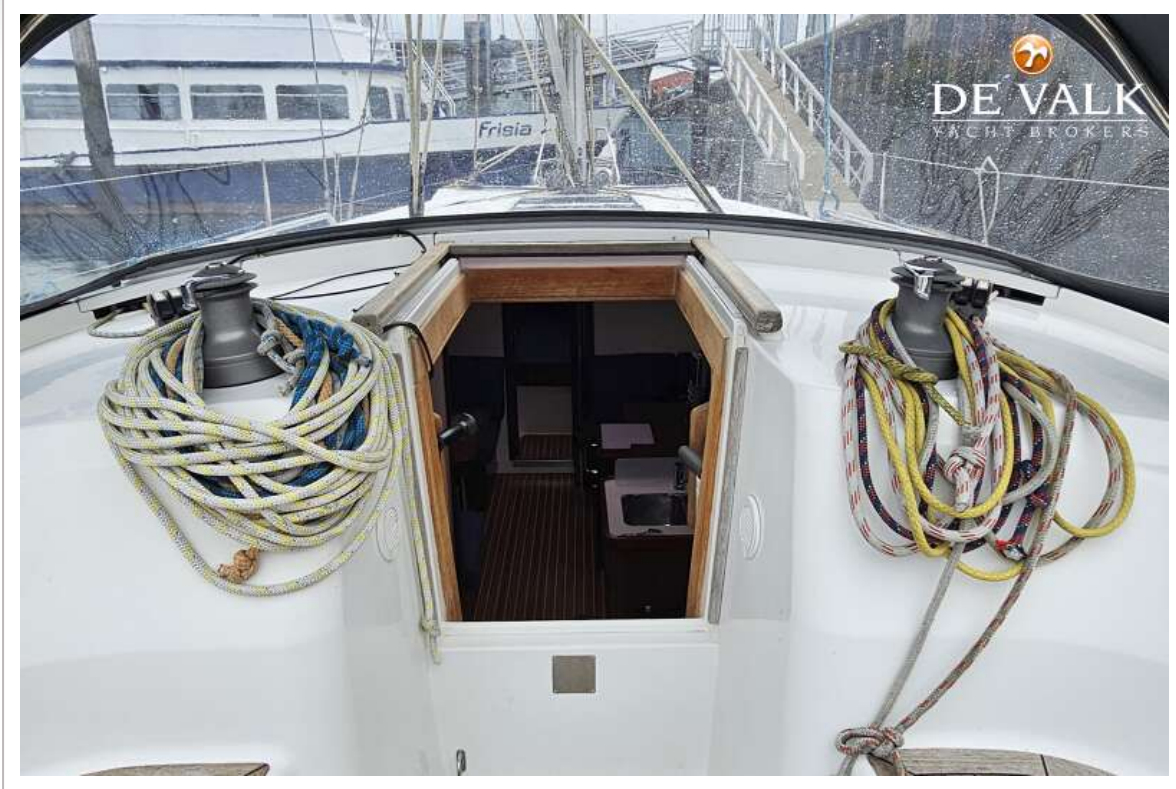
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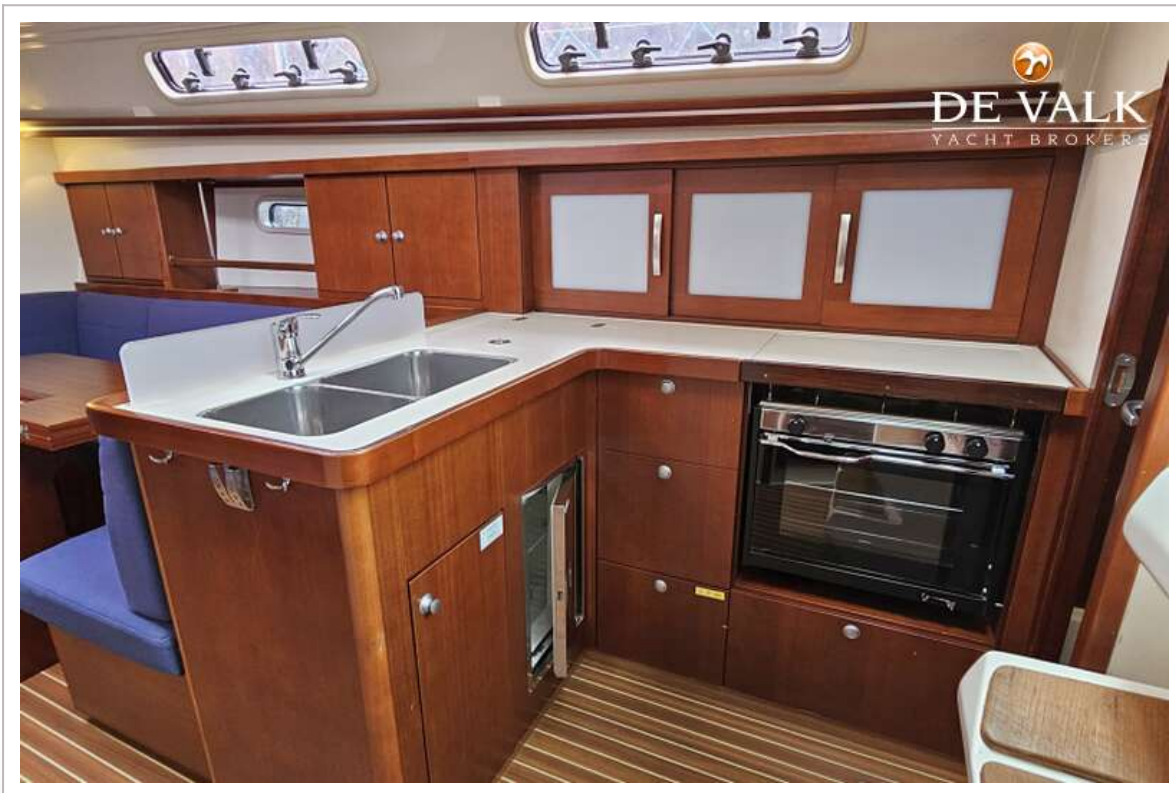
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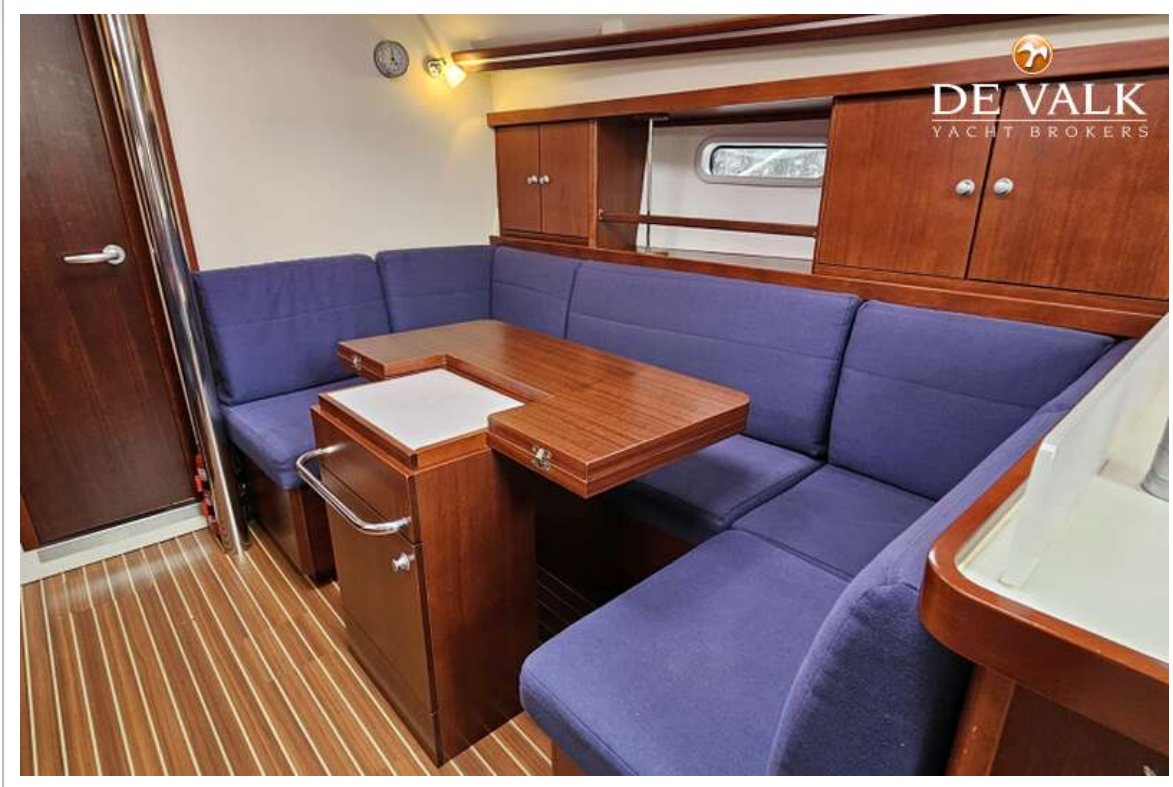
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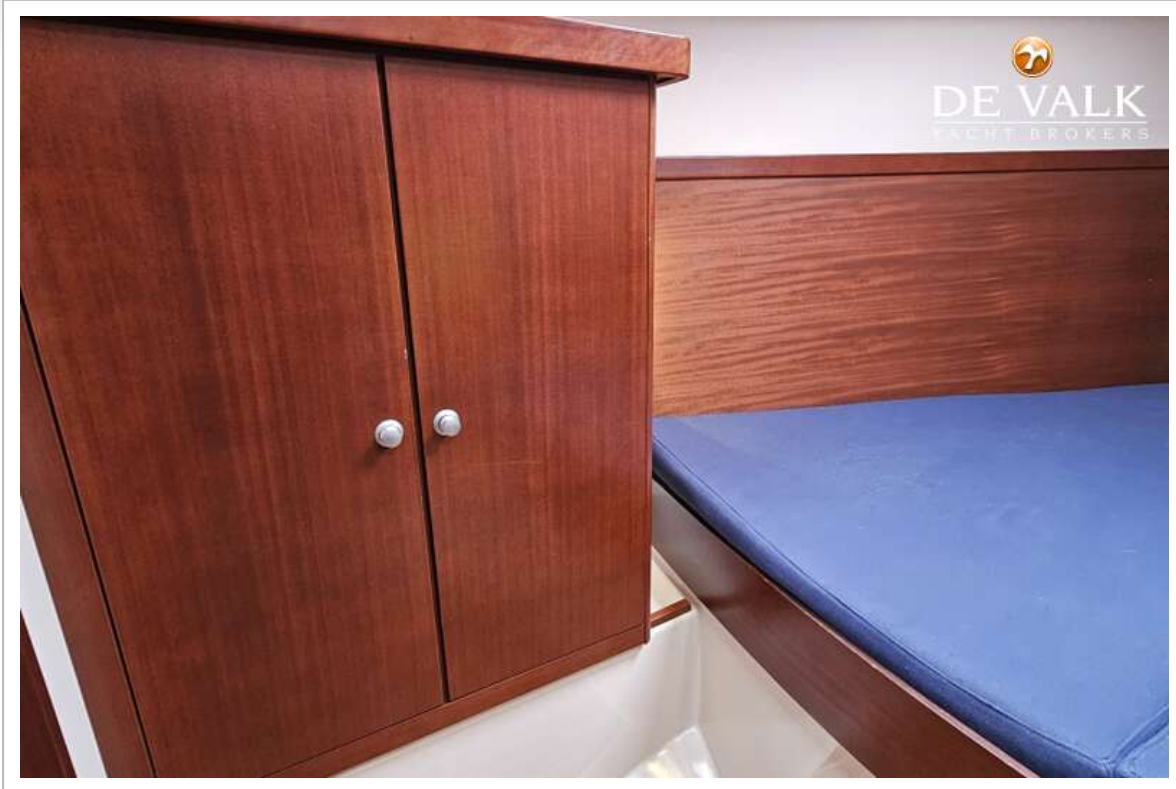
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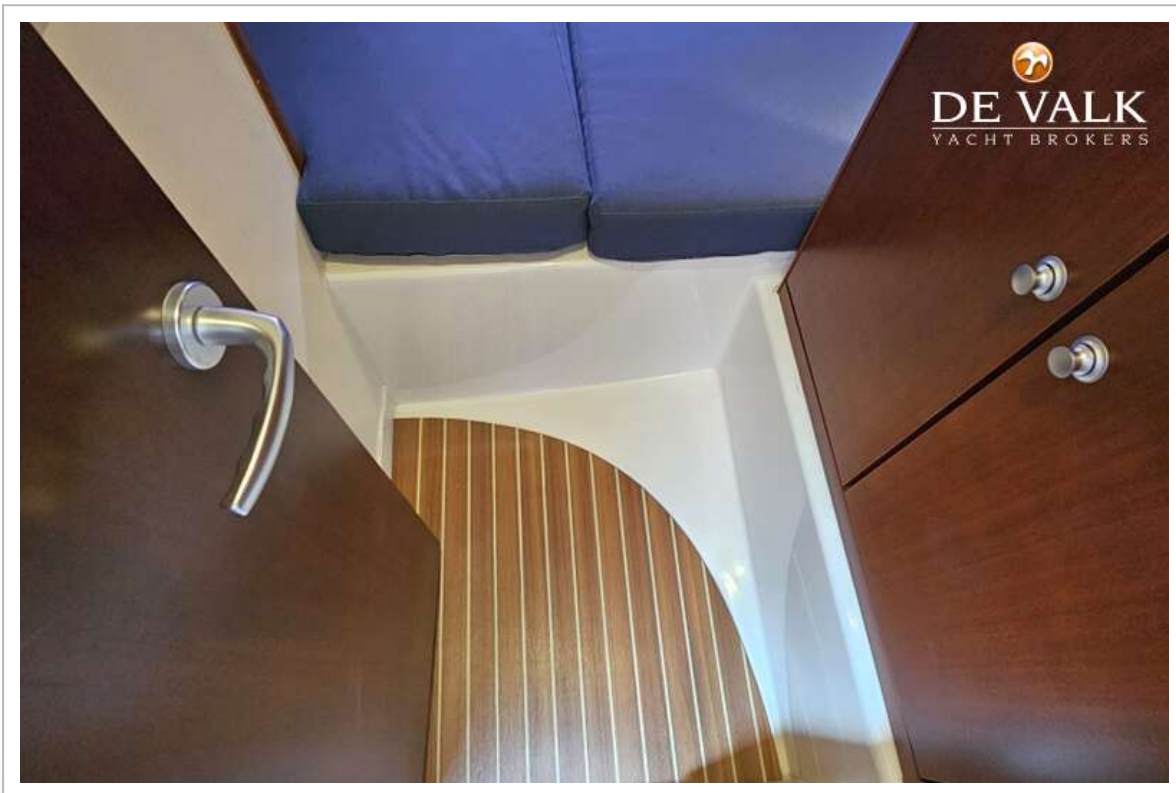
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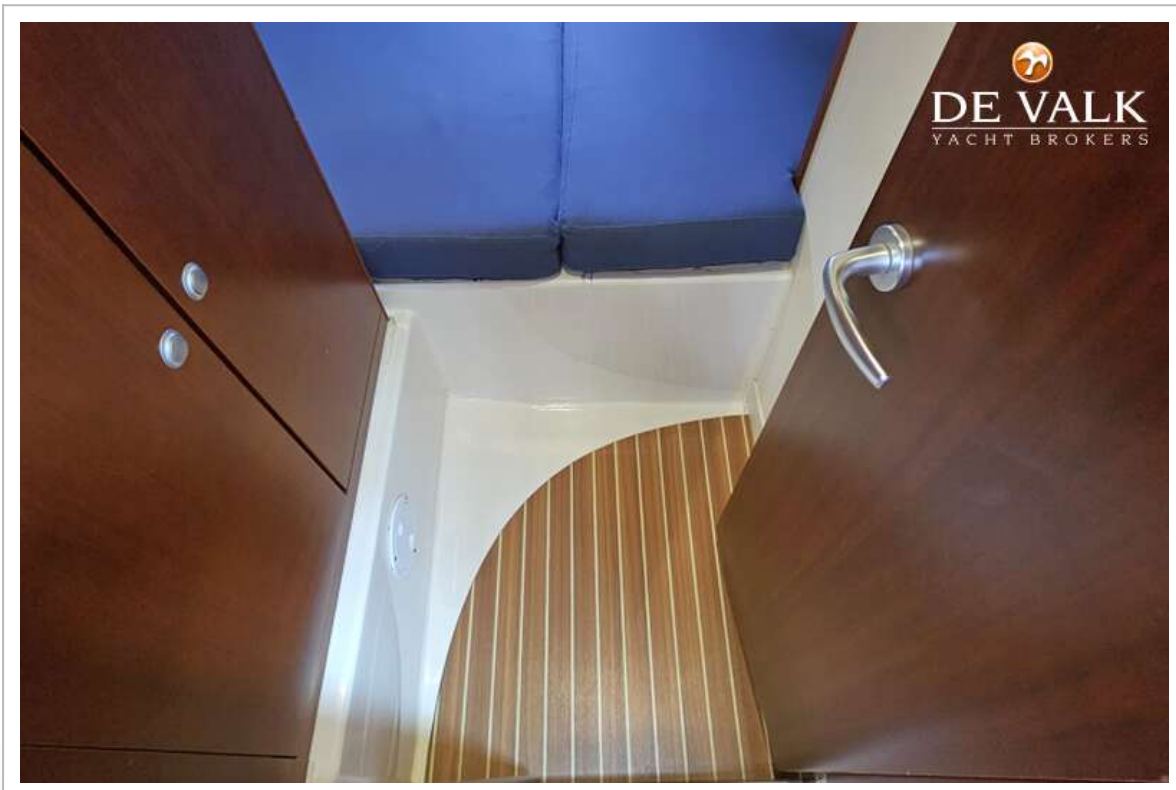
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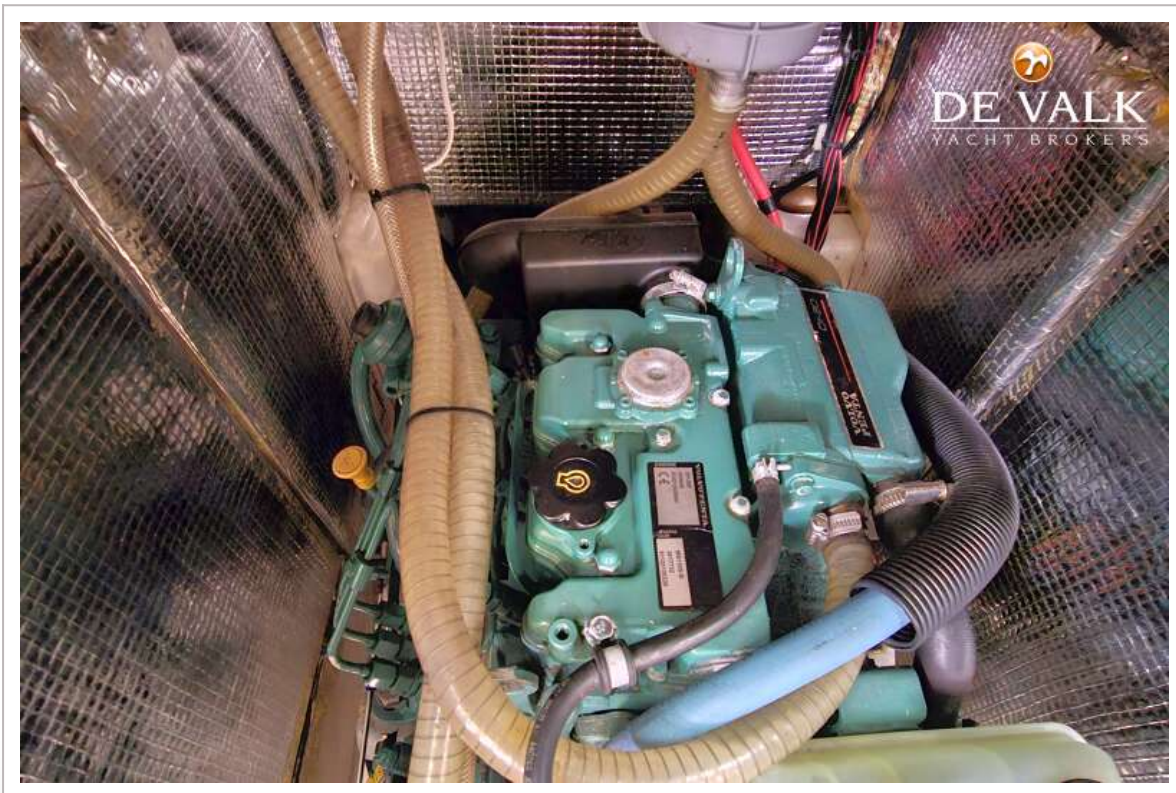


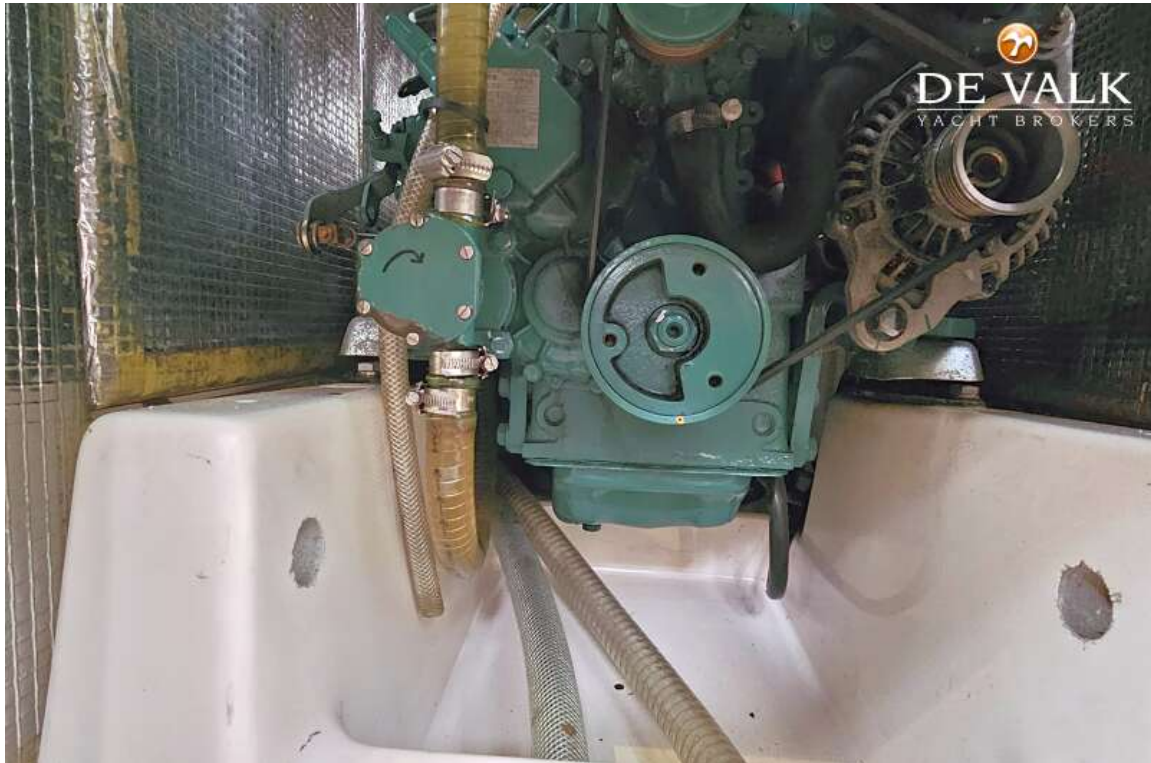


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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



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What is the reason for selling your yacht?

We are expanding to a larger boat in preparation for a longer journey in two years.

How many owners has your yacht had and when?

We have been the second owner since 2015.

What can you tell about the history and cruising area of your yacht?

The boat travelled the German Baltic coast from 2011-2017, and Netherlands (mainly Zeeland) since.

Why did you choose this yacht when you bought it?

The Hanse 375 has a great combination of very spacious and livable interior, easy handling with small crew and outstanding sailing performance. It is also a very reliable boat.

What is the special meaning of the name of the yacht for you?

The name was given by the previous owner, and we liked it and kept it that way. It's also short which is convenient for VHF comms.

Has your yacht ever been used for charter? And if so, when?

Yes, the first owner was a charter firm. This was 2011-2014.

What can you tell about the sailing characteristics of your yacht?

She goes easily 6-7kn cruising speed starting at winds from 10-12kn, even when beating. Top speeds seen have been 8.5-9.0kn. The beat angle is a solid 45°, which give you a great VMG at headwind.

What did you do with your yacht during the winter?

Sails and sprayhood went off each year, and the boat remained typically in the water.

What kind of maintenance or renewals have been carried out (with documentation as prove)?

We continuously maintained, renewed and upgraded sails, nav-equipment, ropes, propeller and others, up until this year, as we didn't really plan to sell her. For more details see documentation.

What are, according to you, future points of attention with regard to the maintenance of your yacht?

The cockpit teak will need revision in 3-4 years, we believe, and the UV-protection of the jib needs rehaul.

Which four keywords would you use to describe your yacht?

Fast, reliable, comfy and easy to handle.
