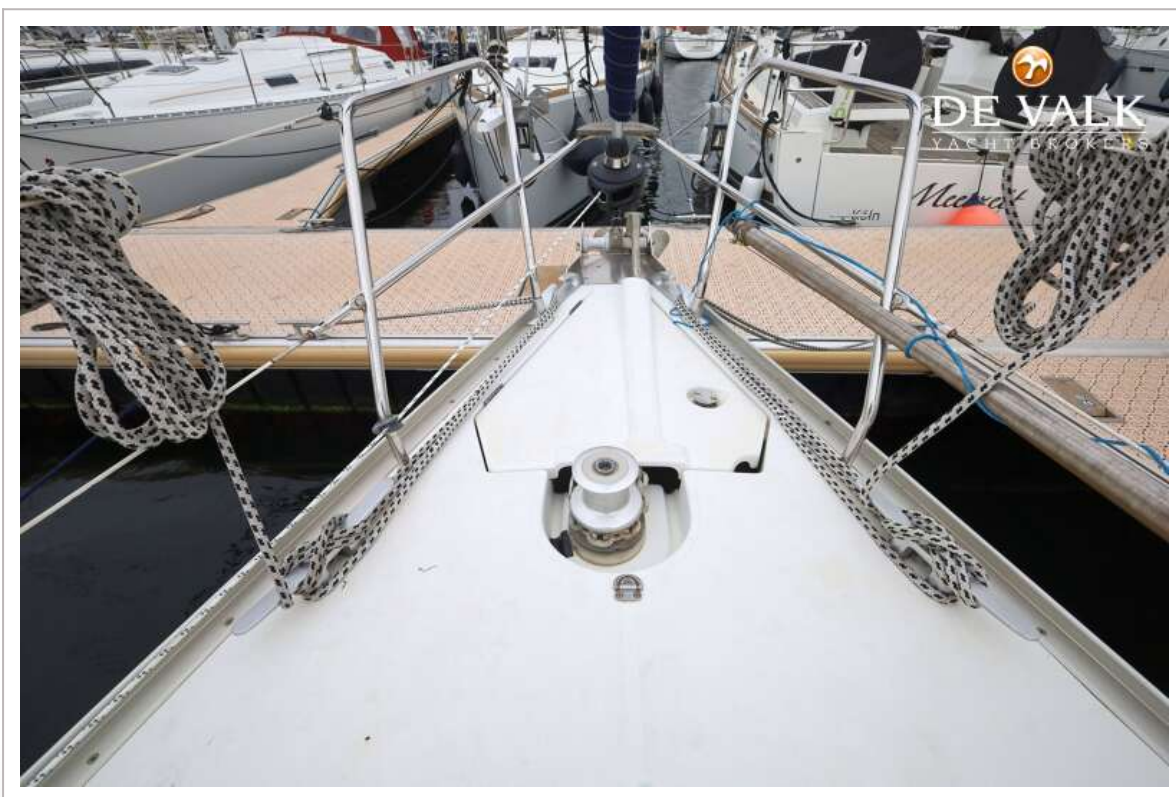
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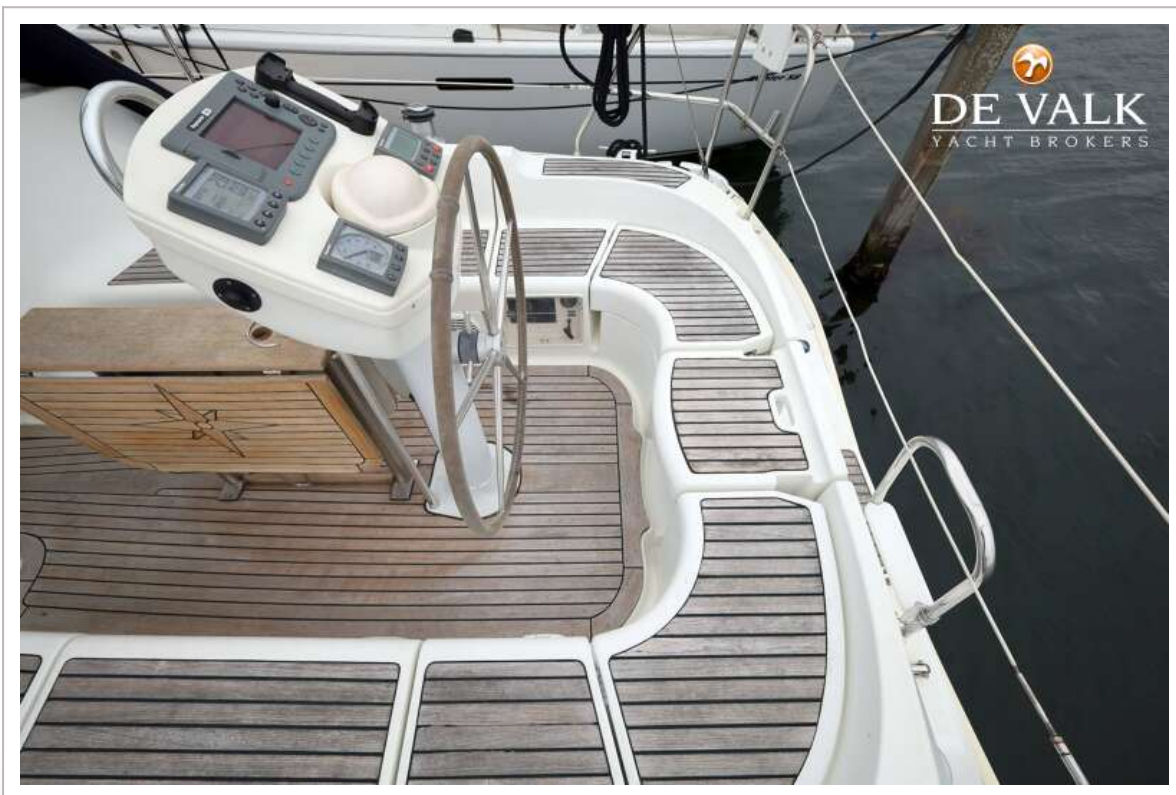
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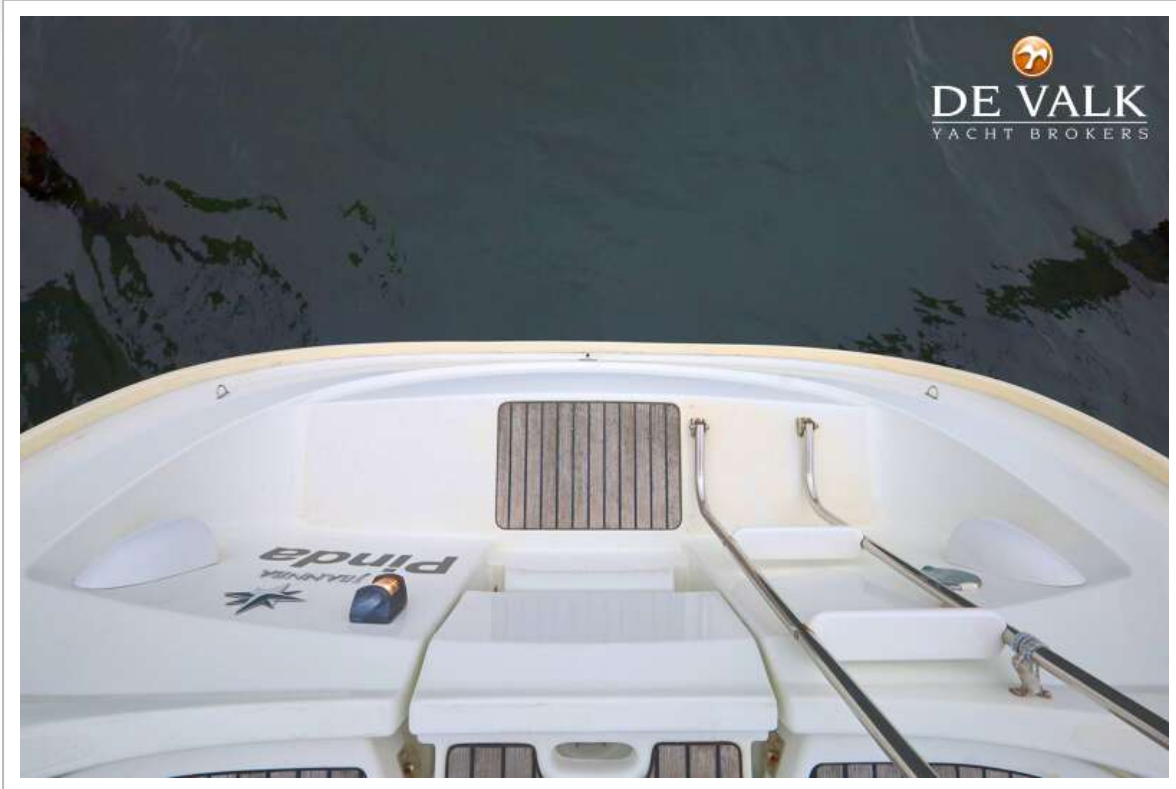
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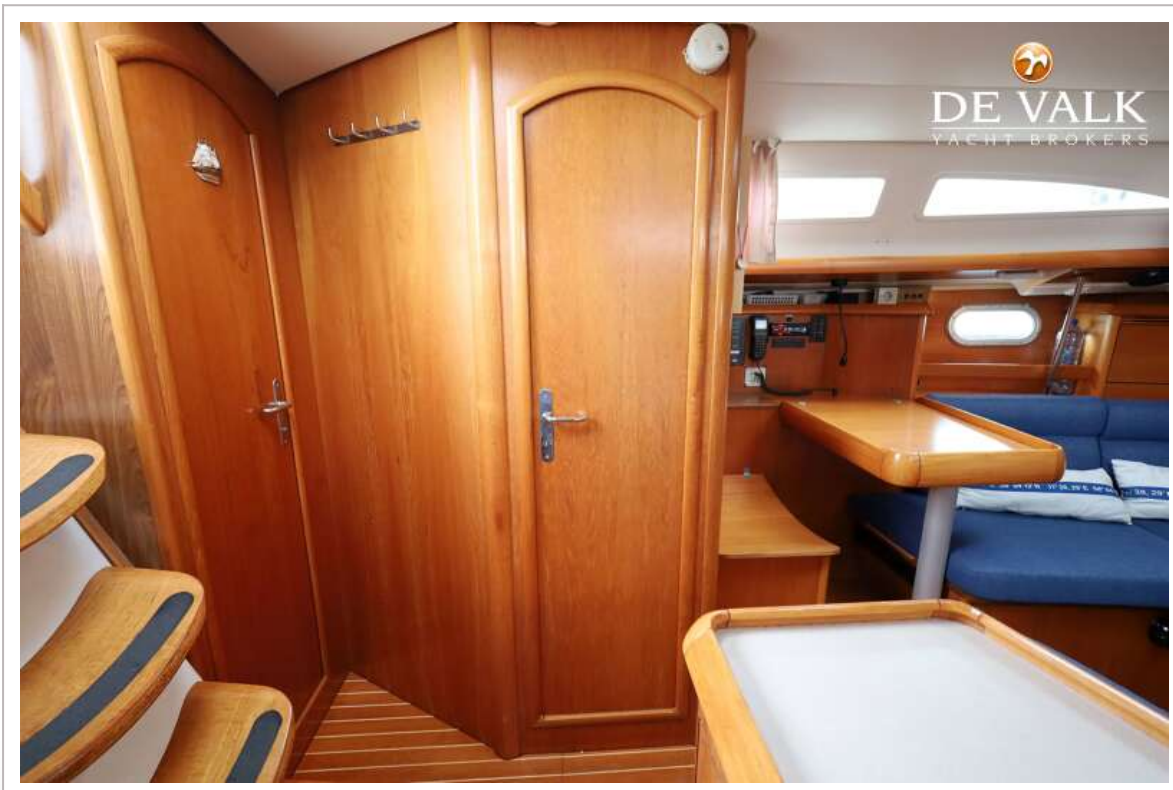
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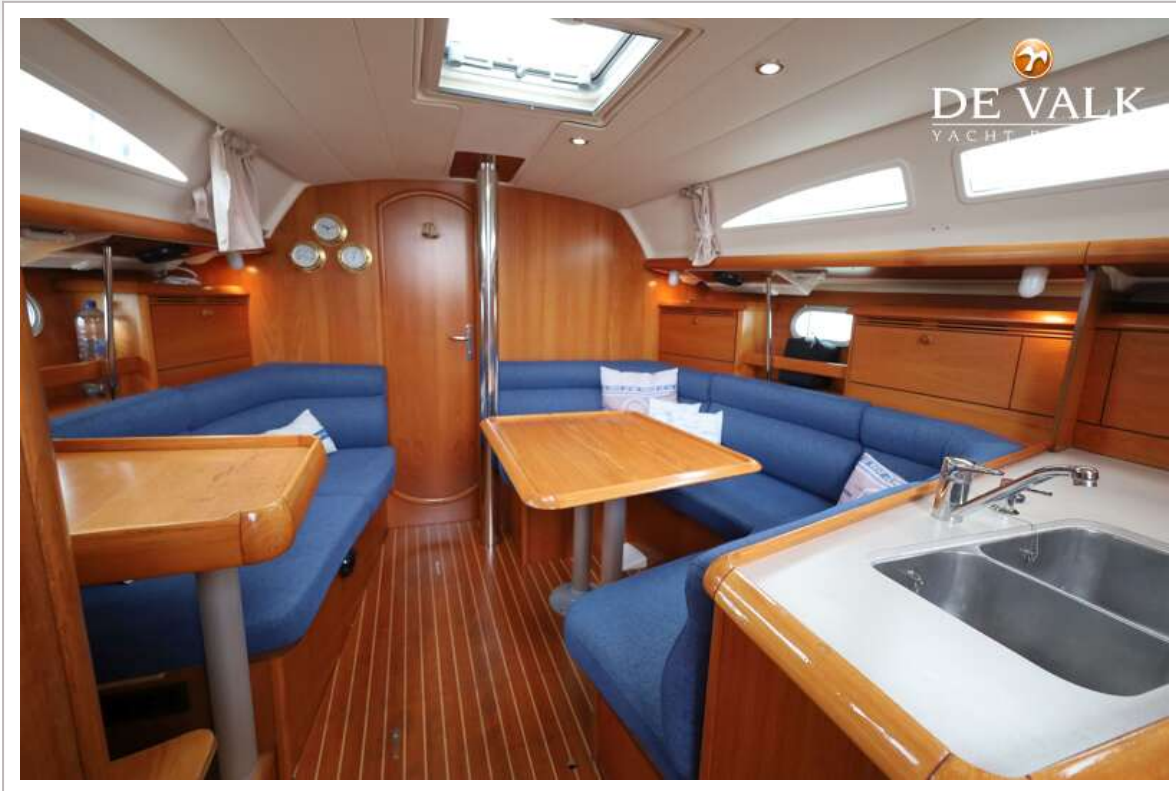
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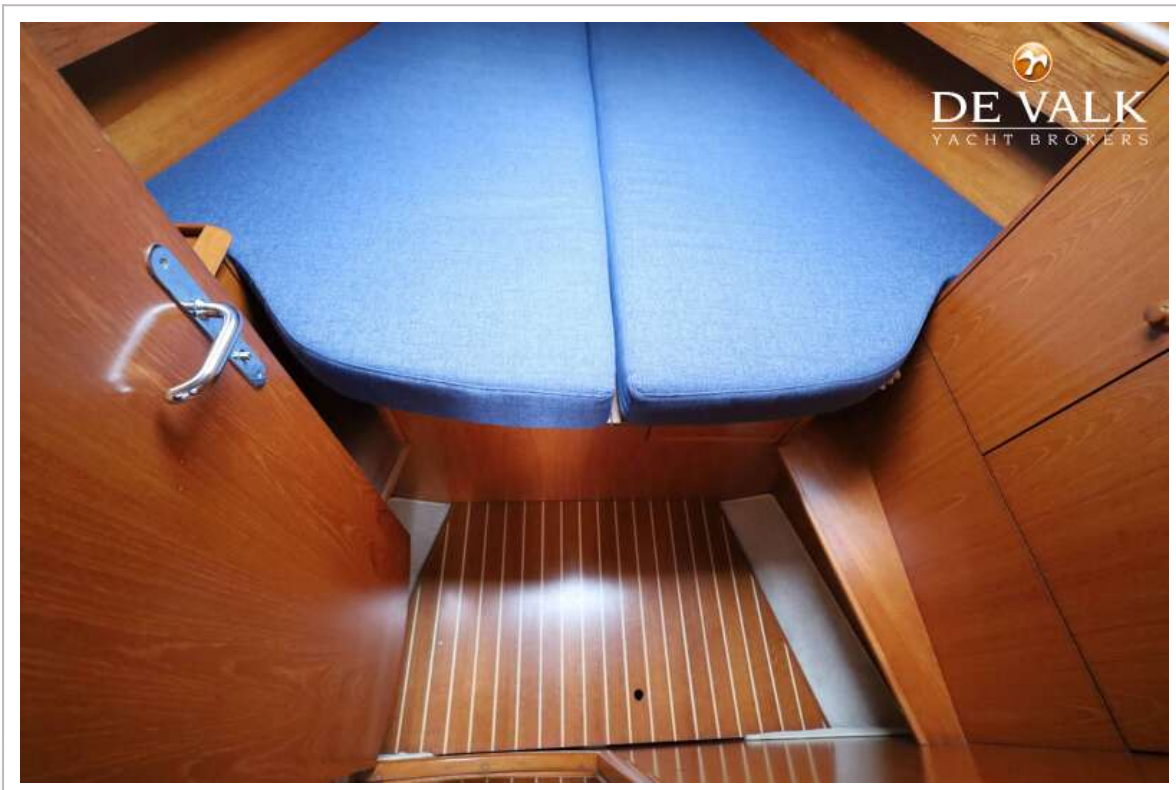
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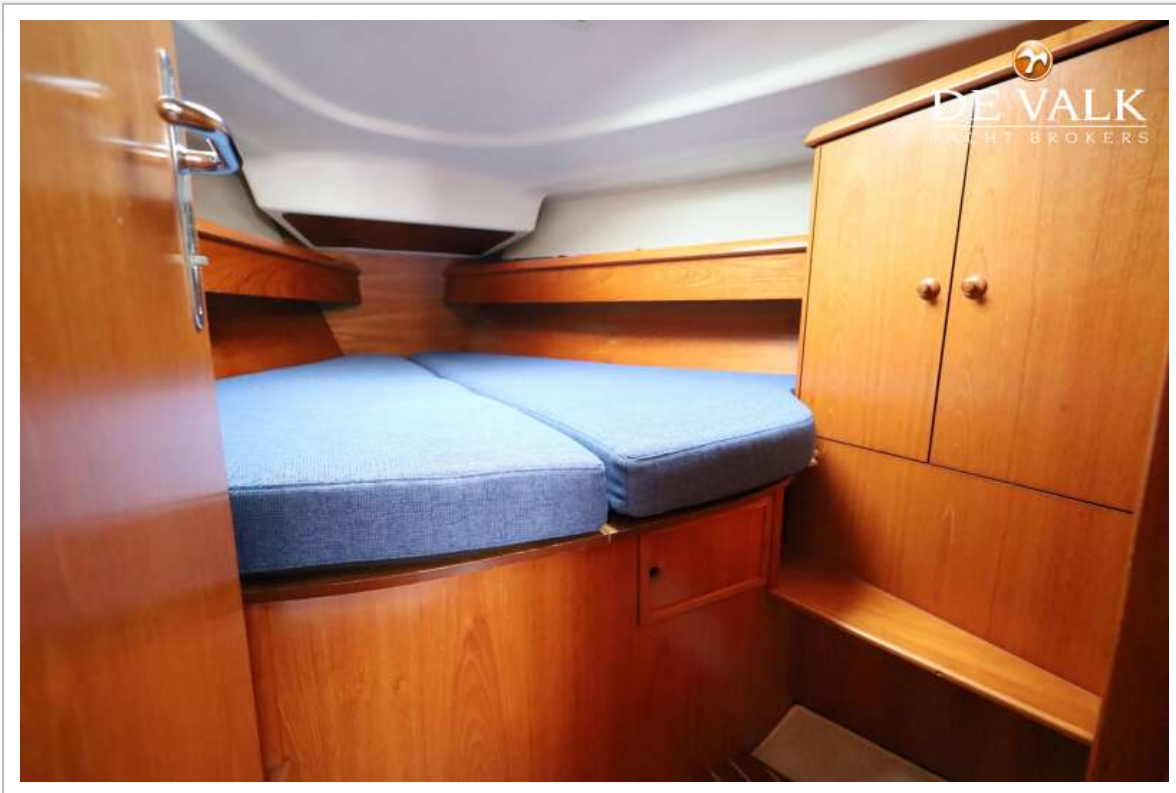
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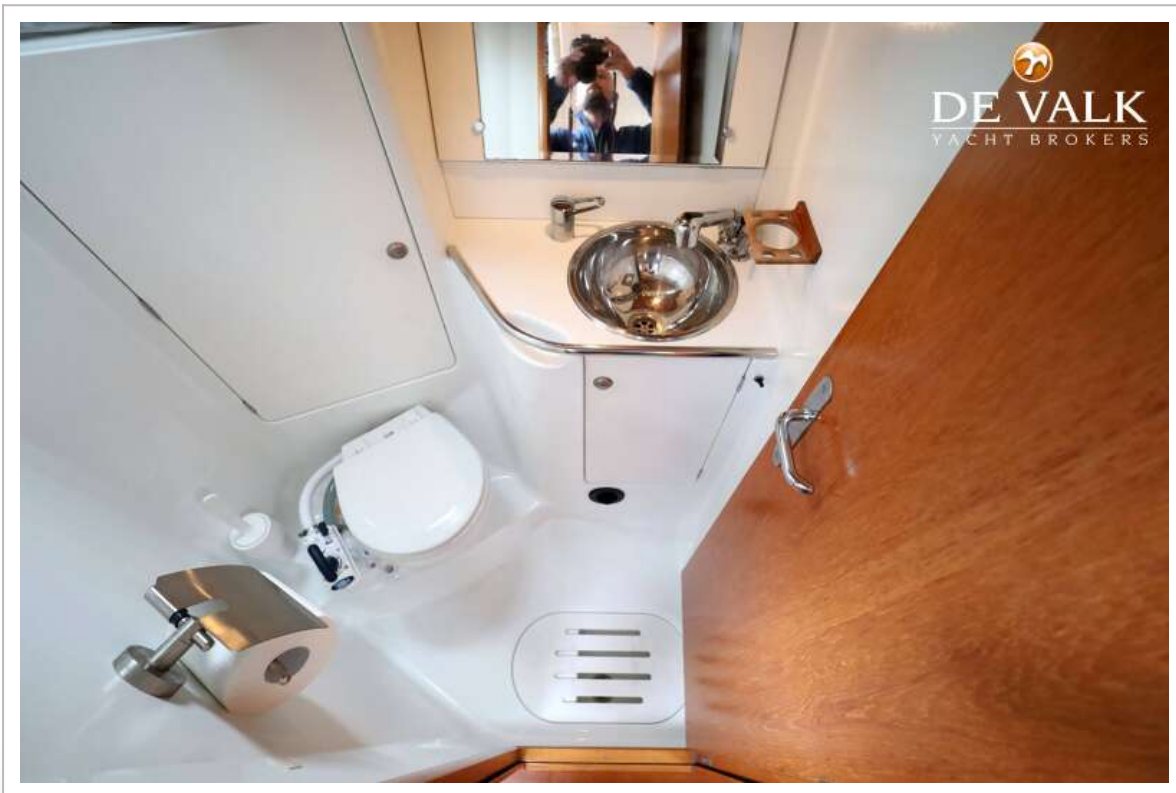
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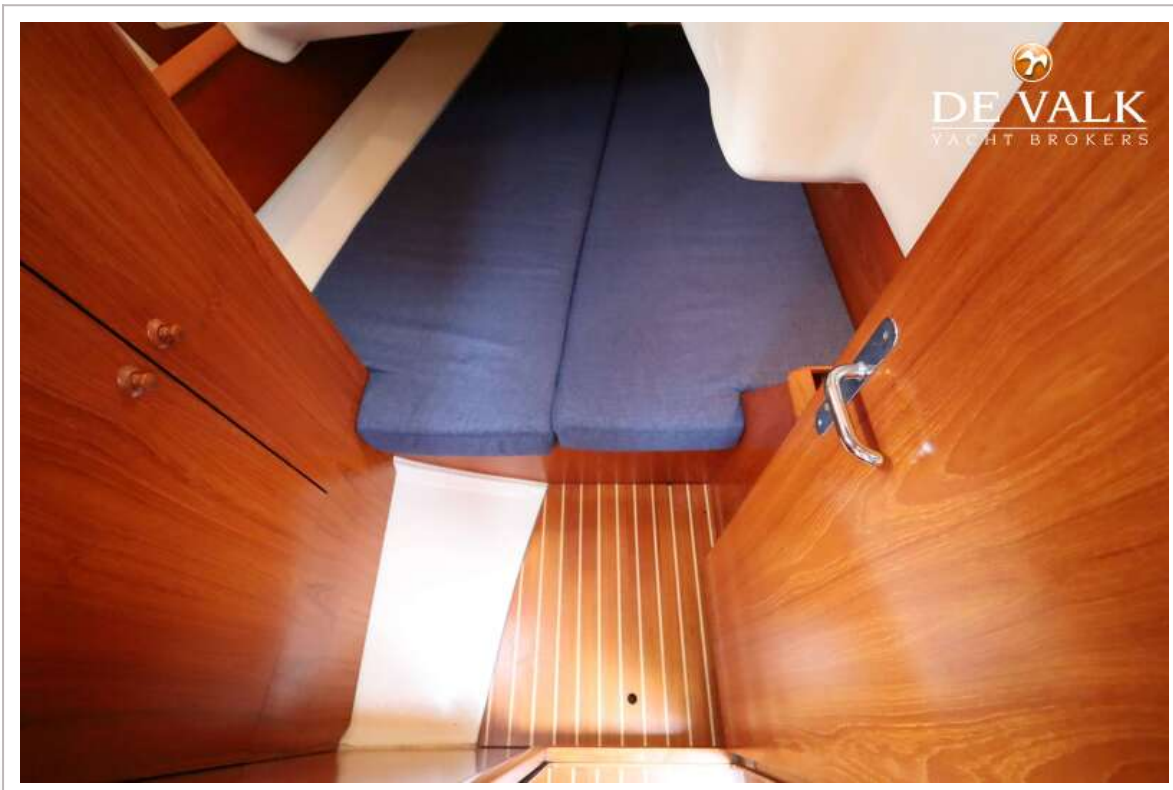
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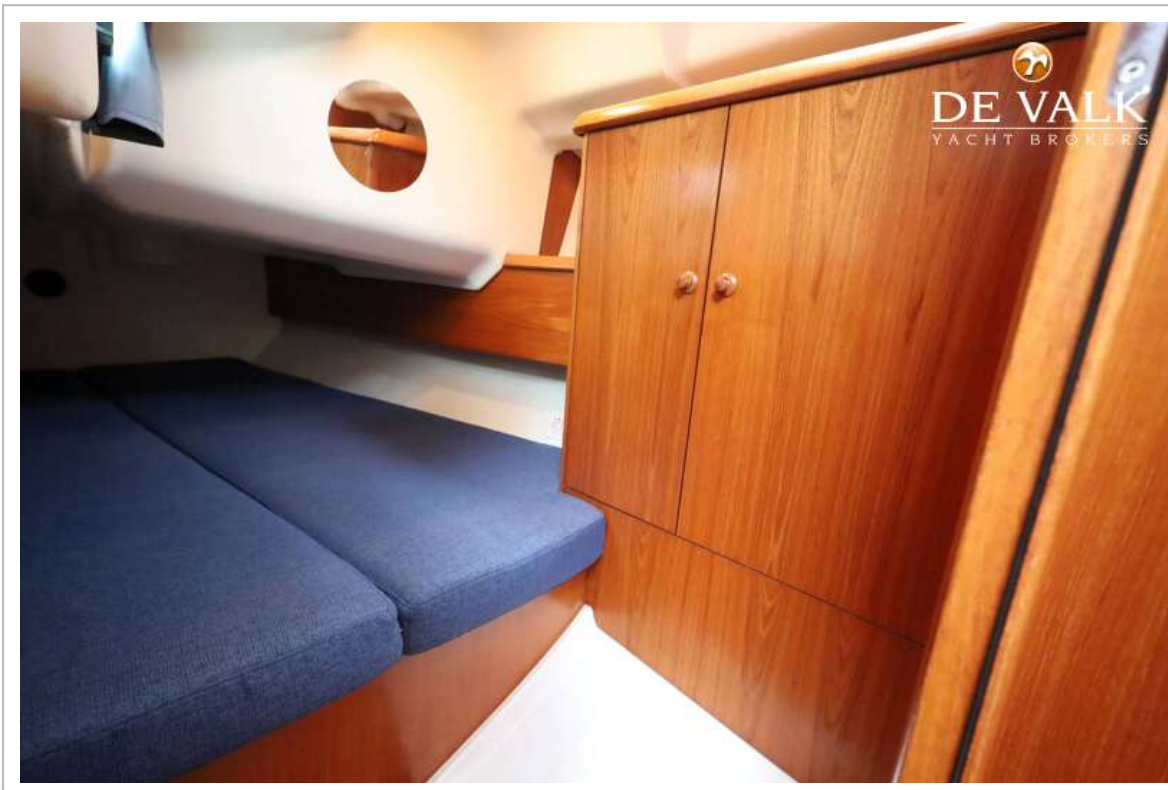
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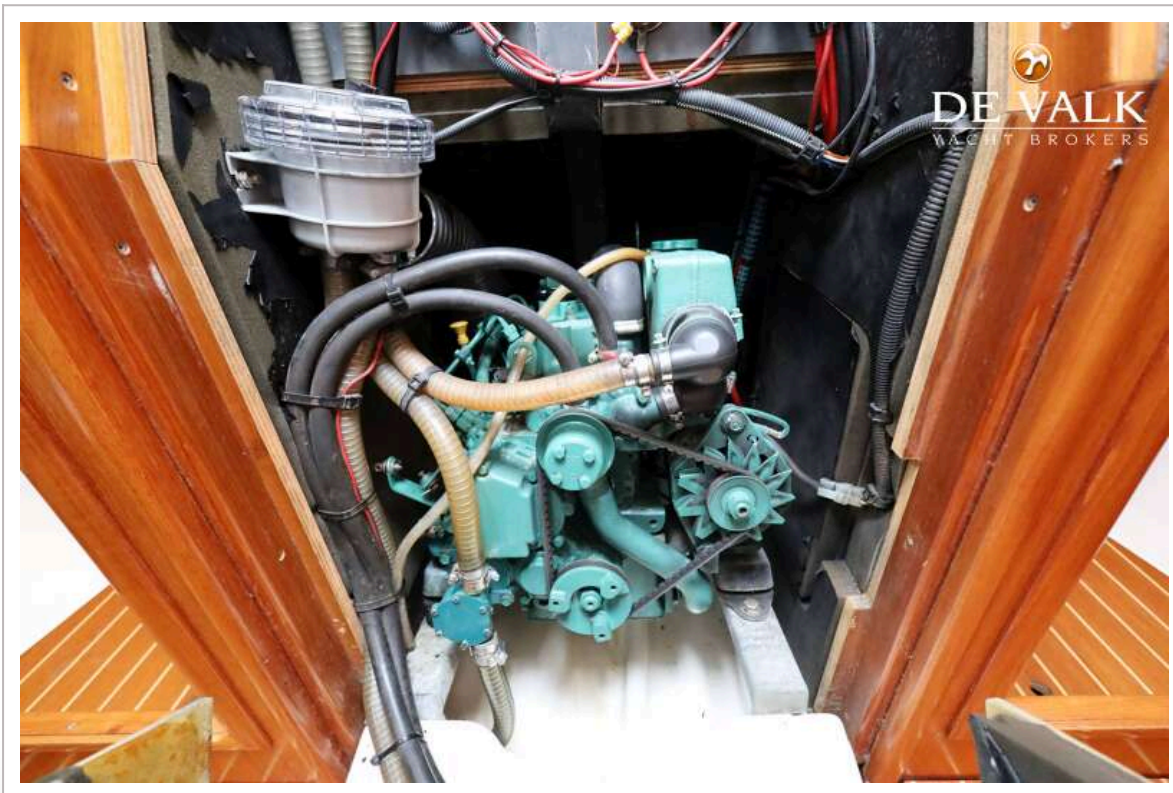
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## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



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### What is the reason for selling your yacht?

*We are selling our yacht due to limited time availability and the relatively long distance to the marina. As a result, we are unfortunately not able to use her as much as she deserves.*

### How many owners has your yacht had and when?

*The yacht has had two previous owners before us.*

### What can you tell about the history and cruising area of your yacht?

*The yacht spent many years in the Haringvliet area and has been based in Bruinisse since 2023. She has mainly been used for private cruising in Dutch coastal and inland waters.*

### Why did you choose for this yacht when you bought it?

*We were specifically looking for a classic yacht with three cabins. The high build quality and well-thought-out layout immediately convinced us.*

### What is the special meaning of the name of the yacht for you?

*We have a soft spot for peanut butter, which is why we named her "Pinda". It's a personal and light-hearted touch that always brought a smile to our faces.*

### Has your yacht ever been used for charter? And if so, when?

*The yacht has never been used for charter and has always been privately owned and operated.*

### What can you tell about the sailing characteristics of your yacht?

*The yacht offers very pleasant and reliable sailing characteristics. She is well-balanced, easy to handle, and provides a stable and safe feeling even in more challenging conditions. At the same time, she performs well under sail, making her enjoyable for both relaxed cruising and more active sailing.*

### What did you do with your yacht during the winter?

*Since we have owned the yacht, she has always been stored ashore during the winter. Twice she was stored outside and once in a hall, always properly winterized and protected.*

### What kind of maintenance or renewals have been carried out (with documentation as prove)?

*The yacht has been continuously and carefully maintained. Regular engine servicing and antifouling have been carried out.*

*Since 2023, the following works have been completed:*

- All interior cushions have been renewed
- Most seacocks have been replaced (except for the shower)
- The stern tube has been replaced
- A new lazy bag has been installed
- Large parts of the standing and running rigging have been renewed
- The genoa furling system has been replaced

### What are, according to you, future points of attention with regard to the maintenance of your yacht?

*The navigation equipment is fully functional but no longer state-of-the-art, so a future upgrade could be considered depending on personal preferences.*
