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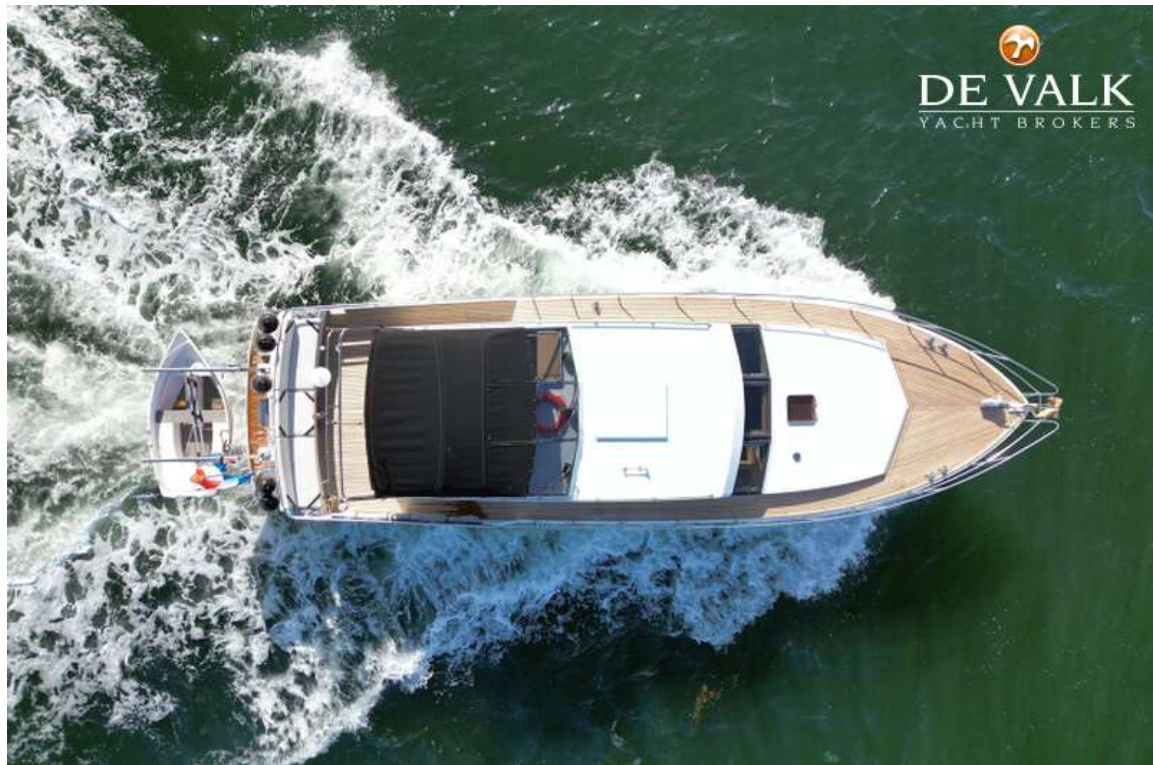
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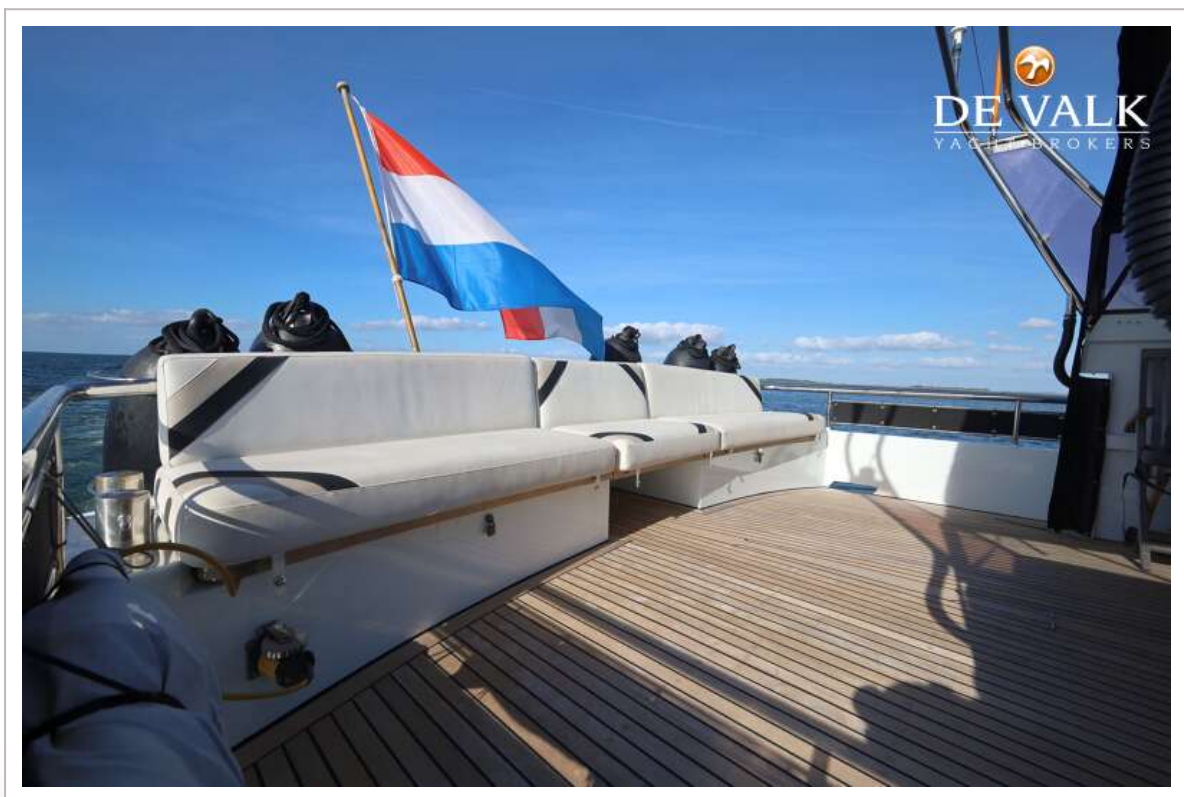
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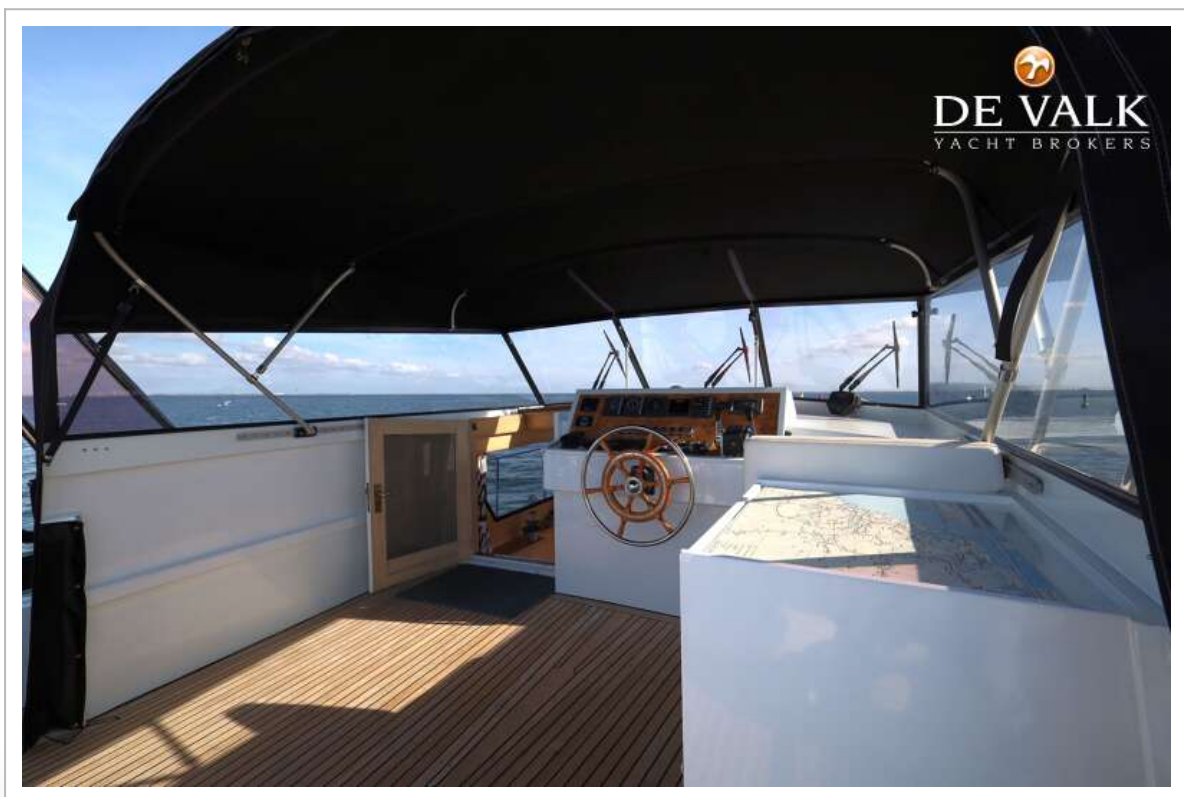
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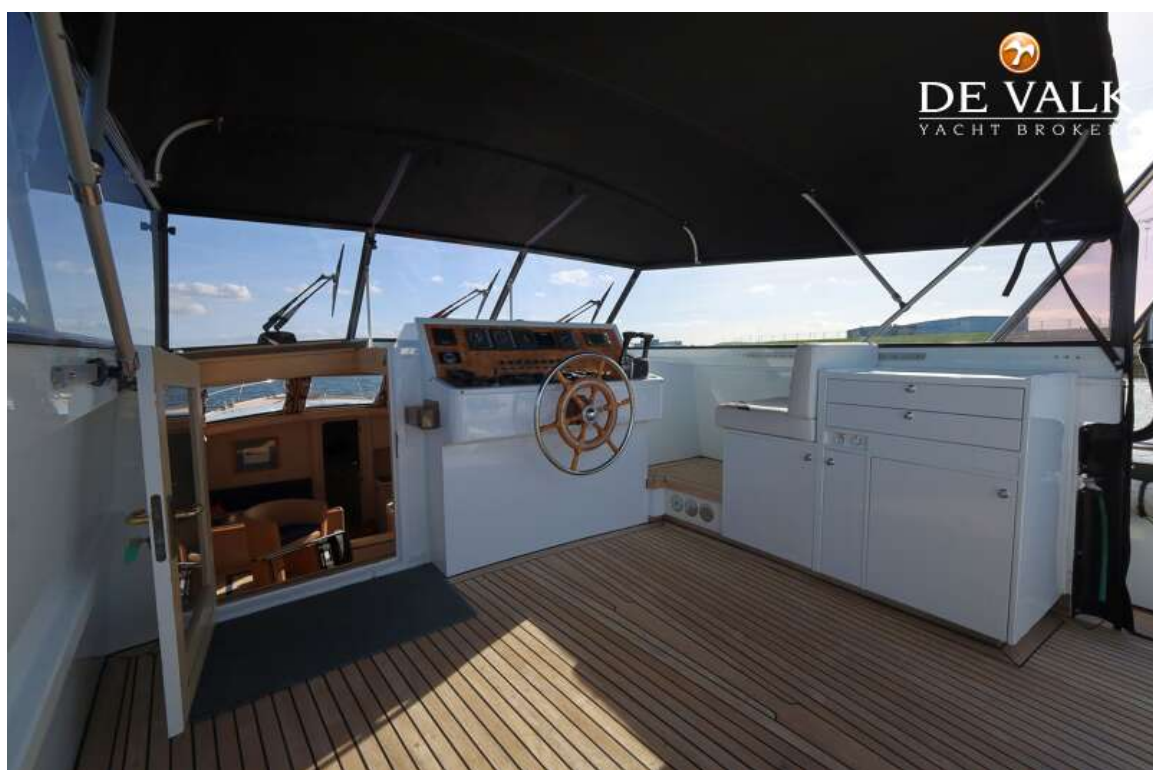
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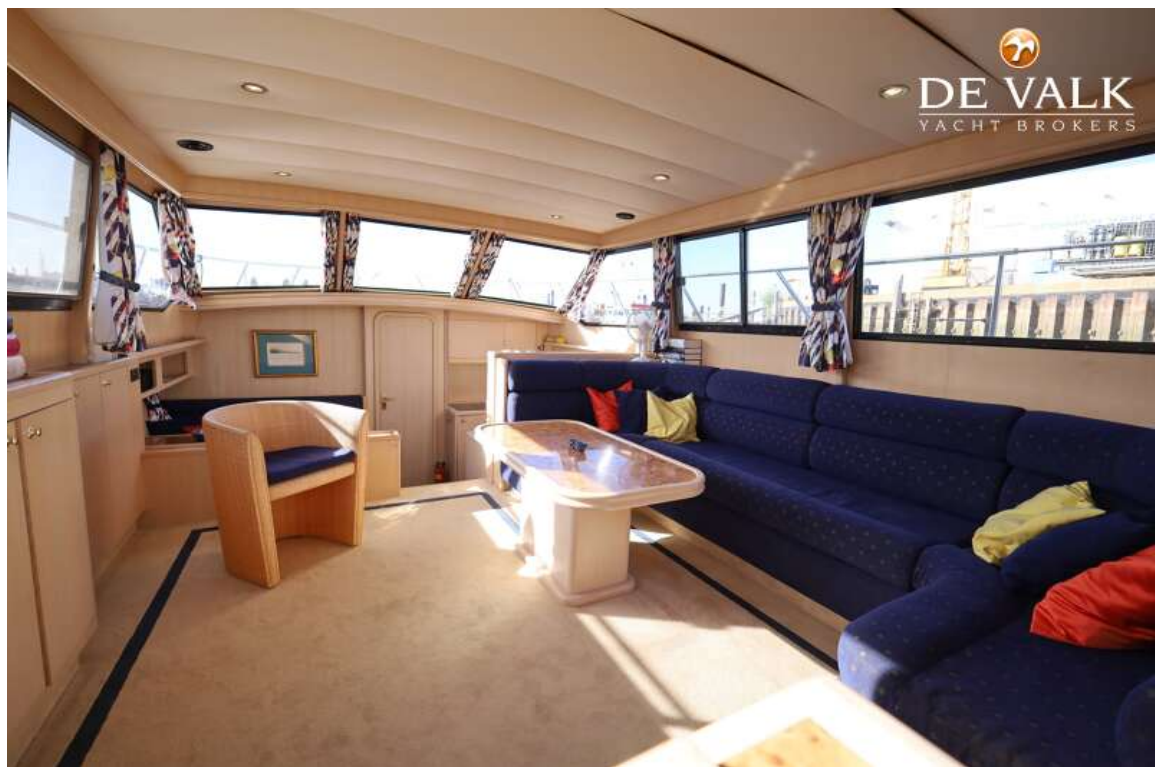
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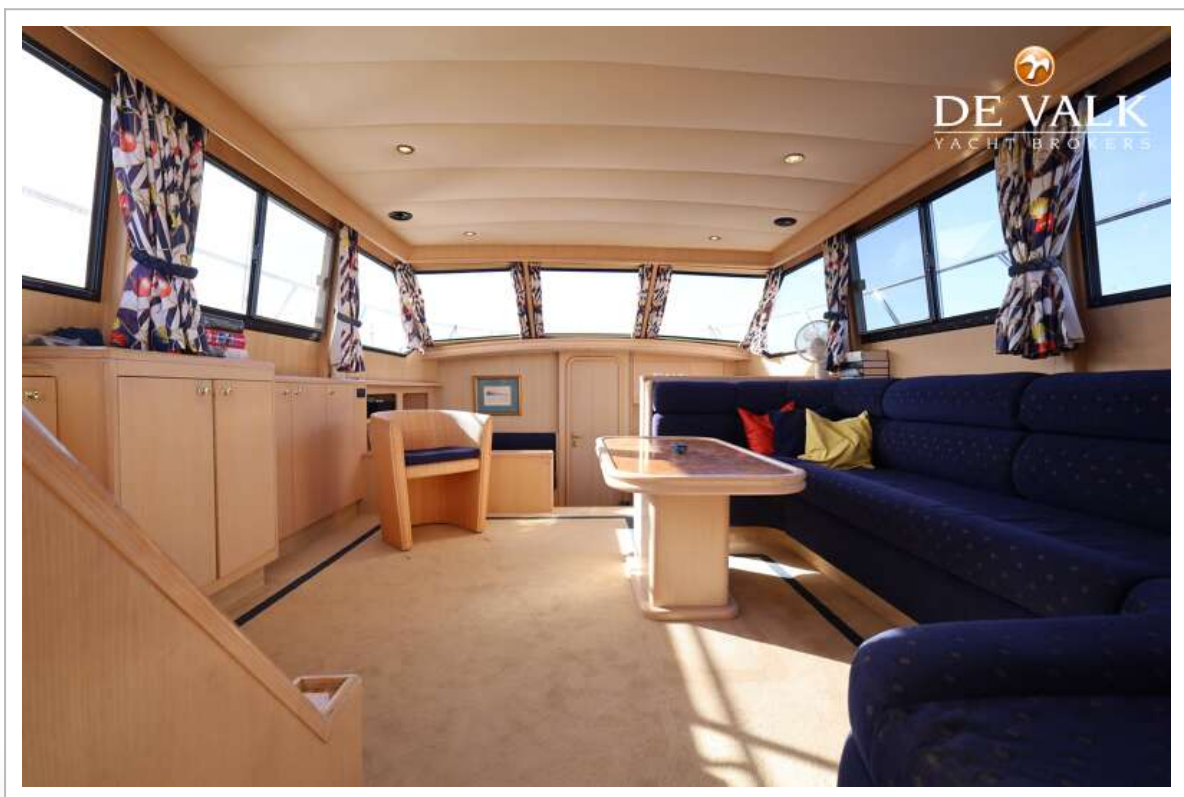
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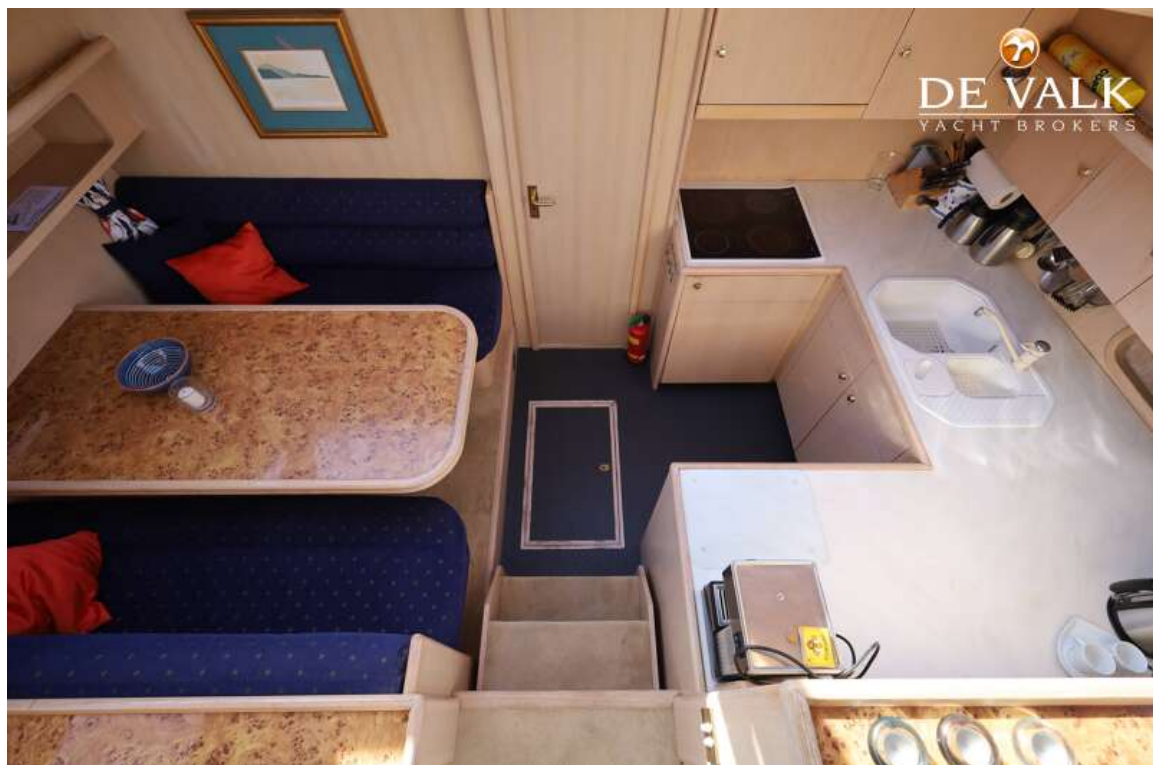
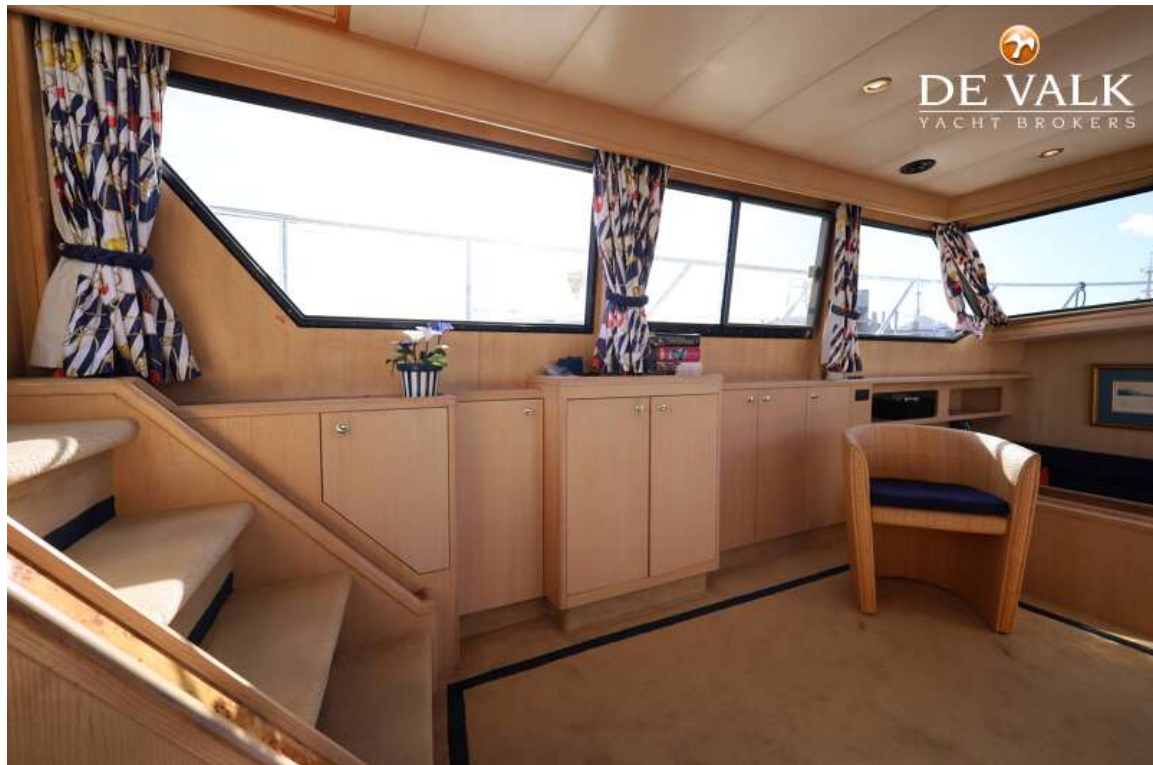
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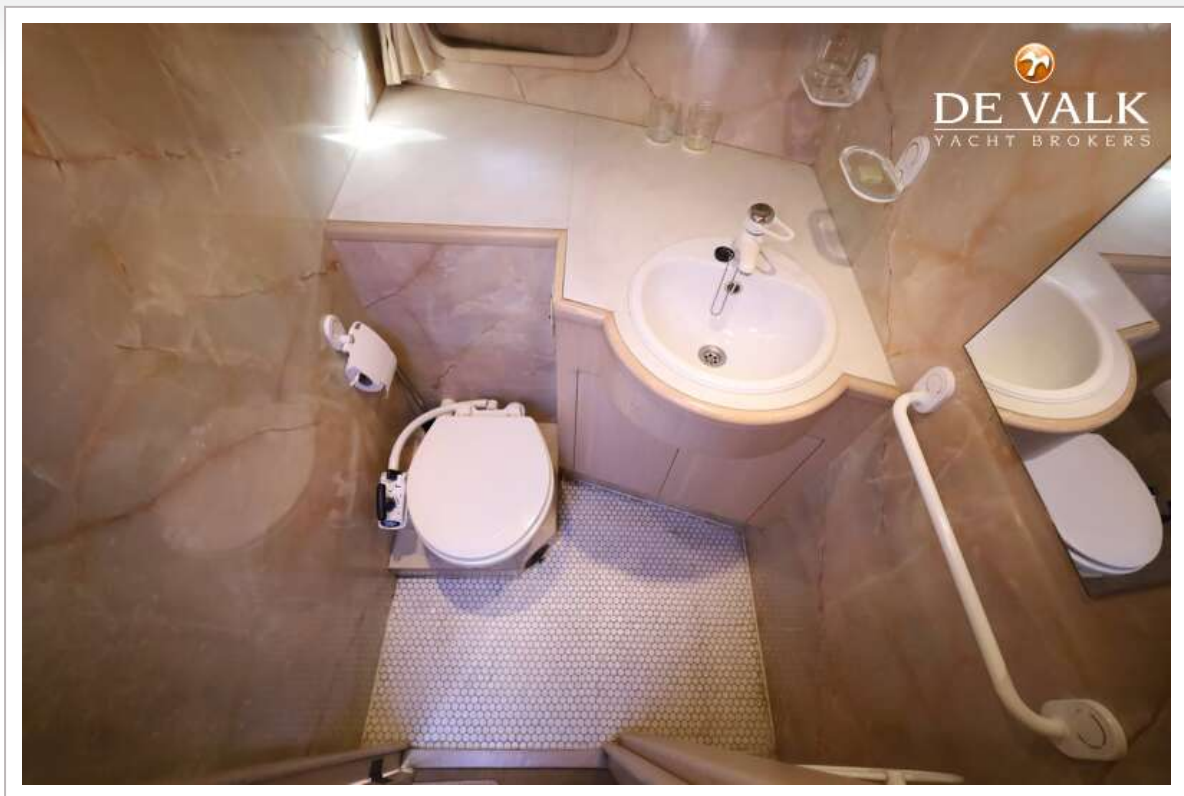
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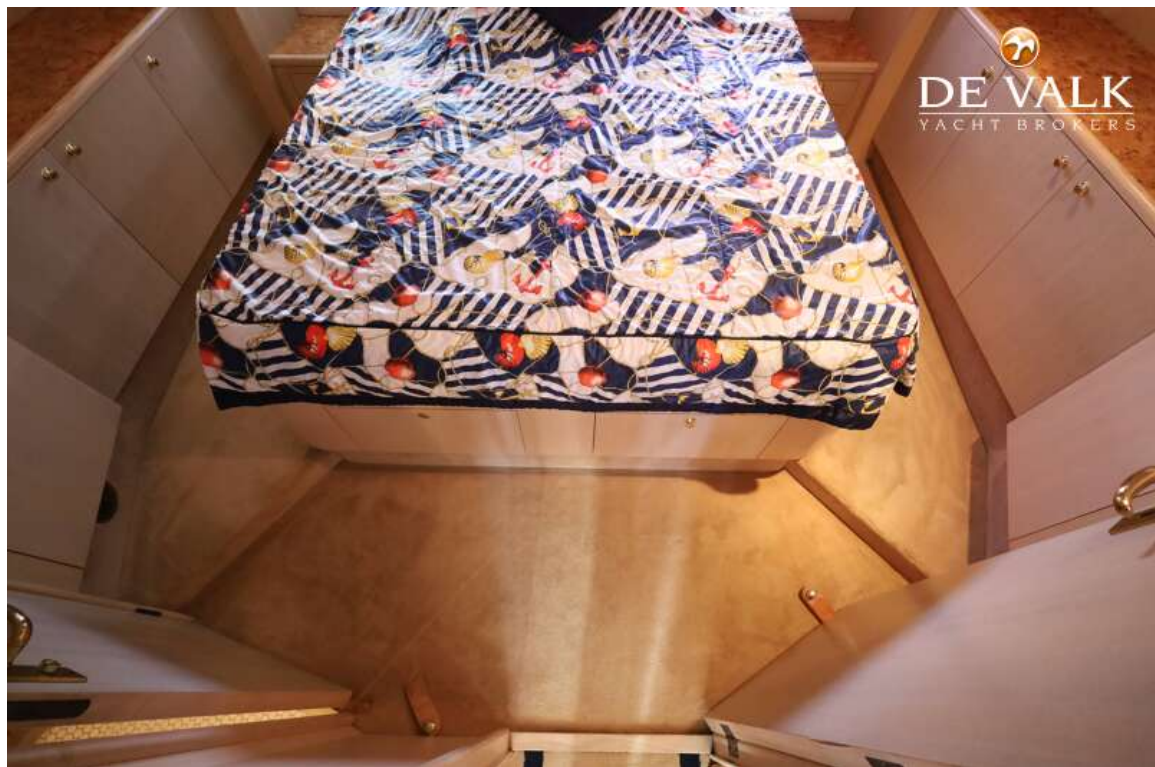
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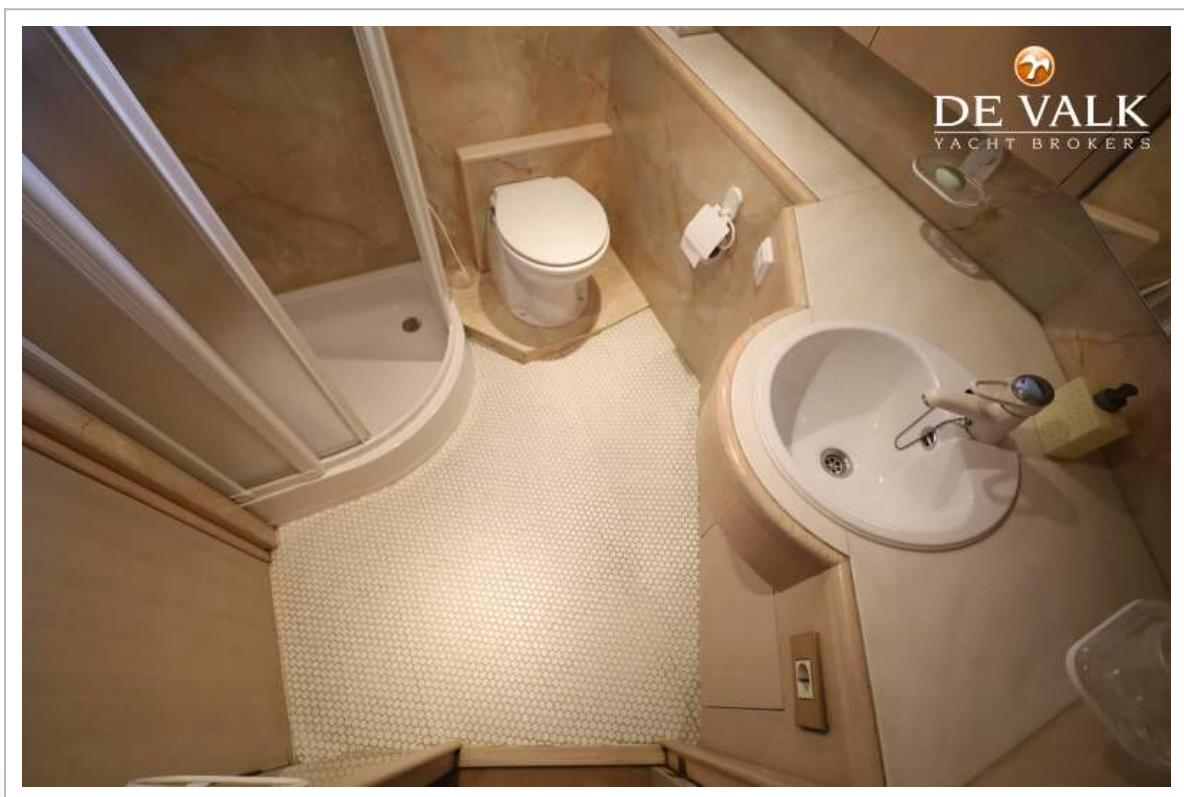
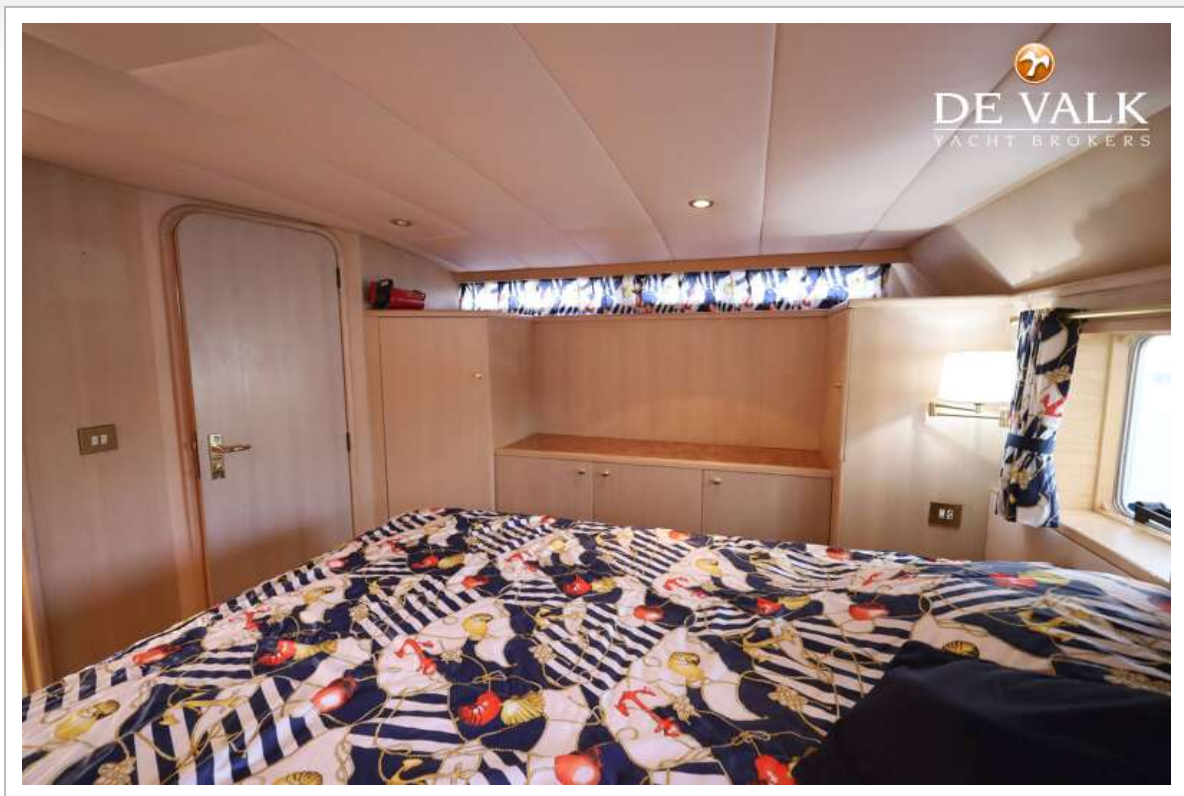
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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



DE VALK

What is the reason for selling your yacht?

Age.

How many owners has your yacht had and when?

We are the first owners.

What can you tell about the history and cruising area of your yacht?

The ship has travelled throughout Europe and spent three years in the Mediterranean without a permanent berth. During the winter, it was laid up in Valence on fresh water.

There have been several voyages to the Baltic Sea and Denmark, each time returning to its winter berth in Yerseke.

England was also visited.

Why did you choose for this yacht when you bought it?

The quality of the shipyard and the specific operational range (i.e., air draft and draft of the motor yacht) determined the purchase.

What is the special meaning of the name of the yacht for you?

The vessel is named "Aotea"; in the Maori language of New Zealand, this means "White Cloud". When the Maori migrated from the Pacific to New Zealand, they named the land "the land under the white cloud," or "Ao-tea-roa".

Has your yacht ever been used for charter? And if so, when?

No.

What can you tell about the sailing characteristics of your yacht?

Given the reputation of the Wim van der Valk shipyard, Van der Valk vessels are extremely solidly built, regarding both steel construction and interior fit-out as well as technical equipment. The engines are sufficiently powerful for open waters yet not overpowered for rivers and canals.

What did you do with your yacht during the winter?

The yacht has always been stored in a heated shed during the winter, with the exception of three winters spent in Valence, when it was stored on the hard.

What kind of maintenance or renewals have been carried out (with documentation as prove)?

The convertible canopy has been replaced, and all interior upholstery work and engine maintenance have always been professionally carried out in accordance with factory standards.

The propeller shafts have been replaced, as have the instrument panels and engine controls at the helm station. All maintenance records are available.

What are, according to you, future points of attention with regard to the maintenance of your yacht?

A steel vessel of this age is prone to spots of rust that require ongoing attention; otherwise, there is no deferred maintenance.

Which keywords would you use to describe your yacht?

Spacious family vessel with versatile applications.
